## SFD Members' Professional Development (PD) Requirements

In order for studios to submit students for exams, Members must accrue a minimum of **15 PD points every 2 years**.

A full list of PD Options and their corresponding points, along with a PD Log will be emailed separately to all Members. Completed log sheets must be emailed to head office 6 weeks prior to the studio's first exam date.

- Members attending all Convention Classes/Workshops on 18-19 January 2025 will be able to accrue a maximum of 12 PD points, leaving only 3 extra points to be gained later in the year. (Please refer to the Convention Timetable for PD points per class.)
- Any points gained from the SFD Convention will be valid for 2 years of exam submissions.
- Studios may add individual points collected from their teaching staff to make up their points total (Teachers Names must be added to the submitted PD log, alongside the points gained)
- Teachers working for multiple studios can submit their points to all SFD Studios that they teach for.
