Venue – Club Burwood RSL

The Dome is located on Level 1 of Club Burwood RSL. EEE uses the dance floor at Club Burwood RSL as the stage is an odd oval shape. The dance floor is wooden with dimensions 11m x 6m. This venue DOES NOT have tarket. EEE will provide resin for dancers. The adjudicator is located in front of the dance floor on the carpet & the audience sits higher in the mezzanine. The performance area is marked out with EEE banners, media wall & wings. Both Male & Female toilets are within The Dome. All dancers MUST come dressed with hair & make up done. A change room space will be provided for quick changes.

Food & Beverages

The Brasserie offers fresh cooked to order meals in true classic brasserie style. The Brasserie is open from 11.30am – 2.30pm for Lunch & 5.30pm – 9.30pm for Dinner. The Café serves light meals & desserts as well as coffee, tea & cool drinks. The café is open 9am – 1am. Drinks can be purchased from the many bars throughout the club & bought into The Dome. There is no external food to be bought in & consumed in the club.

SR – Dancers who have never previously placed in their chosen style

Rest – Those dancers who have placed 1st in SR section or 2nd & 3rd in Rest.

Open – Those dancers who have previously placed 1st

Elite – Those dancers who do more than 15+ hours of classes per week

Championships

Those entered in Champs, will only perform their new non repeat dance in the Champs section & all other routines that Champ dancers are entered in at EEE will be included in results. Judges are aware of the dancers who have entered Champs at EEE as its is noted on their spreadsheet.

Improvisations

Improvisation dancers will receive notification via email by 5pm on Friday for their Improvisation song. Please listen to the song choice prior to competition day & be prepared as dancers will NOT re-listen to the song on competition day. Improvisation is 1min and will be any part of the song. Dancers do not need a costume for Impro.

Competition

A competition is a situation in which two or more people or groups are trying to get something which not everyone can have. A competition is more than just one person, its 2 or more. A competition is an activity or condition of striving to gain or win something by defeating or establishing superiority over others. Please understand that EEE is running a competition, hence why there are combined variety sections in the program. This is to ensure that dancers are competing against another person in a competition environment.

EEE Sydney Titles

Those dancers who reach a top score of over 90% will be invited to EEE Sydney Titles to re-compete for EEE Overall Title Championships in their preferred style. This event will take place in February 2027.
