Venue – Pennant Hills Community Centre

Pennant Hills Community Centre is attached to the Library, opposite the station & shops at Pennant Hills. The Main Hall is upstairs. The stage is traditional wooden floor 12m x 9m. This venue DOES NOT have tarket. EEE will provide resin for dancers. Both Male & Female toilets are in the foyer for spectators. All dancers MUST come dressed with hair & make up done. EEE has booked the 2x downstairs halls for dressing rooms during Troupes & there are 2x sets of bathrooms downstairs also. Access to the stage for dancers is via the internal back stairwell which will be clearly sign posted. Audience members will access the hall via the main entry doors.

Competition
