RULES AND CONDITIONS

- Ages shall be reckoned at <u>1 January 2018.</u>
- 2. Please note eligibility rules.
- Incomplete or Incorrect Entries may not be accepted. Please verify that all details are correct and notify the Convenors
 immediately of any required changes. Changes are unable to be made once the programme has gone to print. **Please
 double check- correct age group entered.
- 4. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 5. Invoices will be provided via the online system (Comps-Online).
- 6. There will be no refund of entry fees.
- 7. All competitors are required to pay for a Competitors Pass.
 - Solo Pass \$3.00 Entry to Solo Eisteddfod Only
 - Group Pass \$5.00 Entry to Group Eisteddfod Only
 - Performers in Primary and High School are exempt from this fee
- 8. Programmes may be pre-purchased via the Entry Form:
 - Groups: \$10.00 Solos: \$13.00 (Including Postage)
- 9. Programmes may also be purchased in person- Groups: \$7.00 and Solos: \$10.00 from
 - Performance Plus Dance Centre: 30A Waghorn Street, Ipswich.
 - The Dancers Warehouse: Briggs Road Raceview.

GENERAL

- 1. These Rules apply to the Music, Dance, and Speech and Drama sections of The Ipswich Junior Eisteddfod Society Inc.
- 2. Rules and Conditions as printed in the Schedules and Programmes are valid for, and continue to be valid for, the period of the Eisteddfod.
- Competitors, teachers, parents and guardians will be regarded as being conversant with the rules of the Society. Lack of knowledge will not be accepted as a bona fide reason for the infringement of any rule.
- 4. Items are open to amateurs only. "Amateurs" are persons who do not earn the major portion of their income from the practice of Music, Dance, or Speech and Drama. Amateurs include individuals who have spot-parts in Theatrical Performance, Concerts, sporadic events and advertising campaigns.
- Competitors compete at their own risk.
- 6. The Committee reserves the following rights:
 - to amend the programme as necessary.
 - to refuse any entry.
 - · to ask any competitor to provide proof of age.
 - to appoint a substitute adjudicator.
 - · to adjudicate on any misinterpretation of these rules.
 - to adjudicate on any issue not covered by these rules.
 - to divide an item if there are excessive entries.
 - · to cancel an item if there are insufficient entries.
 - to combine age groups if there are insufficient entries.
- 7. Decisions of the Committee are final and binding on all matters.
- 8. Protests must be in writing, signed and lodged with the convenor within half an hour of the reason for the protest occurring. Protests must be accompanied by a \$10.00 fee. This amount will be forfeited if the protest is considered invalid, or is overruled by the Committee. Protests can be made only by competitors, their teachers, parents or guardians.
- 9. The Adjudicator's decision is final within the bounds of the Rules and Conditions.
- 10. The Adjudicator has the discretion, following concurrence with the Committee, to withhold a prize.
- 11. All Awards and Bursaries are awarded at the discretion of the Adjudicator and/or the relevant committees.
- 12. Adjudication sheets will be available, free of charge, at the conclusion of each item. These may be obtained at the rear of the venue.
- 13. Competitors, teachers, parents, guardians or other interested parties, shall not discuss competition related matters with the Adjudicator. Communication with the Adjudicator at the Adjudication station is forbidden. All enquiries shall be directed to the Convenor.
- 14. Competitors must report to the Conductor of Sessions before the start of an item. Permission to compete will not be granted to any competitor who has not reported before the final performance has begun in an item.
- 15. Competitors must not perform out of the order as printed in the programme, without prior permission of the Convenor or the Deputy.
- 16. All PERSONS wishing to ENTER the VENUE MUST PURCHASE AN ENTRY TICKET. Competitors may present their competitor pass/es for free admission to the appropriate Eisteddfod.
- 17. Naked flames or fuelled lamps will not be allowed on stage under any circumstances.
- 18. Any competitor who uses a prop in an unsafe manner, or who acts in a manner that could result in personal injury or property damage whilst on stage or backstage, will be disqualified.
- 19. If a 240V extension lead is required, it will be provided by the Convenor. Please notify the Convenor one (1) month prior to the start of the Eisteddfod.
- 20. Competitors must wear suitable footwear at all times when side stage.
- 21. Collection and engraving of Cups, Trophies and Shields etc. are the responsibility of the winners.
- 22. Perpetual trophies must be returned to the Convenor one (1) month prior to the start of the following Eisteddfod.
- 23. Photocopying facilities are not available at the venue.
- 24. Limited ATM facilities will be available from 2018 no Cash withdrawal
- 25. PHOTOGRAPHY and USE of IMAGE for the 2018 IJES DANCE EISTEDDFOD. All persons accept that, by participating in this Eisteddfod, they will be photographed or filmed and that these images may be used by IJES for promotion of the Society. IJES will not pass any image/s onto a third party unless prior approval is sought. Please be aware DANCEvision.TV as the Official Photographic provider, may use images to promote their service at the Eisteddfod. PLEASE CONTACT A CONVENOR IF PRIVACY IS REQUIRED FOR A COMPETITOR.

DANCE

- 1. The Society is now required to pay a fee for each piece of music played at the Eisteddfod to AMCOS/ APRA (refer page 9). Where applicable other payments are the responsibility of teachers and competitors.
- 2. Competitors who have had professional contact with the Adjudicator within the past twelve months will not be eligible to enter this Eisteddfod.
- 3. The Adjudicator reserves the right to terminate any performance. This, however, does not necessarily mean a disqualification or disapproval.
- 4. Competitors must not rehearse on stage, on the balcony, in the foyer or in the aisles of the venue during the Eisteddfod.
- Competitors are not allowed to wear uncovered tap shoes in the venue.
- 6. Competitors must have "taps" attached to their shoes in all items where tapping is performed. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Back-stage personnel may inspect shoes.
- 7. Competitors' shoes must not be painted with an oil-based paint or spray as this could make the stage slippery. Please check with your teachers. Anyone breaching this rule will not be allowed to appear.
- 8. Competitors who stop during a performance and leave the stage may reappear for comments only. (Except for 8 years and under and Novice Items).
- 9. Competitors must perform in the relevant age items in Solo, Duo and Trio items.
- 10. Competitors must perform in their given item as listed in the programme.
- 11. Item routines are not allowed to be repeated in multiple sections except for designated Championship and High Score Champion Items. Changes of music and/or costumes do not constitute a change in routine
- 12. The Novice Solos Items are only open to competitors who have never been placed First, Second or Third in the genre being entered at any previous Dance Eisteddfod prior to entry closing date.
- 13. Restricted Groups are for Dance Studios who did not place First, Second or Third in that genre, at the **Ipswich Junior Eisteddfod**. These items are designed for smaller and /less competitive dance schools. The committee would appreciate if entering these items is done so in fairness to other entrants. Please contact a Convenor for any clarification.
- 14. Competitors in the Jazz Championship items who are not present at the beginning of the Item when called by the Conductor of Sessions will be automatically excluded(due to the improvisation component)
- 15. Competitors in Championship items must perform in the order as printed in the programme or disqualified.
- 16. To be eligible to compete in a Championship item, a competitor must have performed in the following relevant items:

Tap Championship
 Song & Dance Championship
 Tap – Solo/ Waltz/ Speed (Any two only)
 Song and Tap or Song and Dance

Jazz Championship
 Classical Championship
 Lyrical or Contemporary and Jazz – Up-Tempo
 Classical – Solo and Character/Demi-Character

- 17. Please note that from 2018, competitors in **Championships** may **REPEAT** some item dances (see notes in item section).
- 18. Vocal backing is not permitted in the vocal section of Song and Dance items or Musical Theatre Items.
- 19. Competitors in Solo items may perform only once in any item, including Novice Items.
- 20. Competitors in the Duo or Trio items may perform a maximum of twice, in any item, with a different combination of partners.
- 21. Participants are not allowed to perform in more than two groups in a Group item. Participants may perform in more than two school groups in a Primary or High school Group item.
- 22. All Group items must have a minimum of four (4) dancers.
- 23. All dressing rooms are Unisex. Anyone requiring special consideration must notify a Convenor prior to commencement of the Eisteddfod. Dancing Studios must use the allocated dressing rooms.
- 24. Time limits include entries and exits and are maximum times. Exceeding the time limit **will result** in deduction of points or may result in the disqualification of that performance.
- 25. Stage curtains will remain open throughout the Eisteddfod and may only be used for the Primary School Group items.
- 26. The Conductor of sessions may ask teachers, parents or friends to leave side stage if they deem it necessary.
- 27. Children are not allowed to sit on the floor of the venue in front of the Adjudicator or in the aisles.
- 28. Competitors/performers must present the appropriate Competitor's Pass for admission to the Group or Solo Eisteddfod.
- 29. A sound technician will be provided to play all music throughout the Eisteddfod. CDs ONLY will be accepted for solos. Labels will be posted out with your programme and are to be placed on CD cases before your arrival at the venue. The CDs should be handed into the back table at the beginning of each session. Groups have the option of using CDs or electronic devices.
- 30. Prompting of competitors by teacher and/or parents is not permitted. (With the exception of 5 years and under items).
- 31. All female competitors must wear tights for all performances. (With the exception of Acrobatic Items only).
- 32. All competitors in Own Choreography and Improvisation Items are required to wear basic dance attire in a plain colour. No sparkles or studio logos.

DANCE GENRE DESCRIPTIONS (helpful for entering correct genres)

Solo Tap:

Any style or tempo of tapping, including techniques such as: tonality, musicality, rhythm and syncopation. No pre-recorded Tap sounds in the music are allowed. Tap shoes must be worn.

Waltz Tap:

Same as the above Tap description, but must be choreographed and performed in a 3/4 time signature.

Speed Tap:

Same as the above Tap description, but must be choreographed to a fast tempo and performed at that pace.

Song & Dance Tap:

Tap technique must be used in this division. The singing elements and dance segment of the routine should be evenly balanced and equally strong. No voice backing vocals allowed during the song component. Voice over/backing vocals are allowed during the dance component.

Song & Dance:

Any genre of dance technique (except tap) may be used in this division. The singing elements and dance segment of the routine should be evenly balanced and equally strong. No voice backing vocals allowed during the song component.

Voice over/backing vocals are allowed during the dance component.

Musical Theatre:

A live presentation from a stage or film Musical. Must include singing, a line of dialogue and dance moves. Must be presented in the style from a stage or screen musical.

Cabaret:

A routine with emphasis placed on entertainment value, with characteristics of what one might expect to see at a nightclub or a restaurant. Performance and costuming must be family friendly.

Broadway Jazz:

Routine should be based on Jazz Technique, stylized using exaggeration, quirkiness and athleticism so that the movement is story and character driven.

Jazz Up Tempo:

A routine comprised primarily of Jazz technique, performed to Up Tempo Music.

Hip Hop:

Consists of Street, Funk, MTV video style Jazz techniques.

Lyrical:

Consists of Jazz and Ballet technique, with an emphasis placed on strength, control and musical interpretation. Should include emotional and storytelling elements.

DANCE GENRE DESCRIPTIONS (cont'd)

Neo Classical:

Comprised of Ballet technique and Classical lines of movement. There may, however, be a minimal diversion from the Ballet aesthetic to include some parallel work, flexed feet and angular arm lines.

Contemporary:

Consists of Modern and Ballet technique, reaching beyond the standard Jazz Vocabulary. Should be primarily based on recognised Methods (but not limited to) such as:

- Cunningham Technique
- Graham Technique
- Horton Technique
- Limon Technique

Using concepts such as: contraction, release, gravity and weight, swing, rebound, fall, recovery and suspension.

Classical:

Routine must be comprised of Ballet technique incorporating formal classical movements and lines.

- · No repertoire allowed.
- Acrobatic/gymnastic tricks are not allowed in this category.

Character or Demi-Character:

A genre based on Classical Ballet technique, where the storyline and/or portrayal of a character must be as strong and equal to the dance component. No repertoire allowed.

National:

Must represent a country and its traditions, using authentic music, steps and costuming.

Acrobatic:

A routine containing acrobatic movement/gymnastics: routine must contain 50% dance choreography. May contain contortion work.

Novelty:

A routine that includes innovative dance movements that incorporate a theme, concept or characterisation throughout the entire performance.

Own Choreography:

Routine has been choreographed by the dancer who is performing it.

Improvisation:

Involves creating and executing movement spontaneously, without any premeditated movement.

CODE OF ETHICS

Performers are expected to afford the same consideration to others as they would expect for themselves, **at all times.** To ensure that adequate consideration is given, we ask that you understand and abide by the following rules:

- Give due acclaim and encouragement to each other in the spirit of friendship in which the Eisteddfod movement has been fostered over the years.
- Do not attempt to intimidate or distract a performer at any time.
- When entering the auditorium do not walk in front of the Adjudicator. Please take your seats quickly and remain seated at all times while a performance is in progress.
- Maintain silence from the time that a performer appears on stage until the end of the performance and while the Adjudicator is speaking.

AUDITORIUM RULES

Entry / Exit

Doors will be closed during performances - entry to, or exit from the auditorium will not be permitted.

Silence

Members of the audience are requested to maintain silence and to remain seated during performances, adjudications and announcements.

Photography / Recording

Under copyright law, and child protection requirements, the use of cameras (including mobile phone cameras), video recorders, cassette recorders or MP3 recorders is FORBIDDEN, unless specifically authorised by The Ipswich Junior Eisteddfod Society Inc., for official/publicity purposes.

Professional videotaping and photography is available through **DANCEvision.TV**. who are situated in the foyer.

Mobile Phones / Electronic Devices

All mobile phone and electronic devices (including pagers) must be switched off or placed on silent.

All attempts are made to provide accurate information in the Dance Programme. If names or descriptions are incorrect, please advise the committee, and this will be noted for future programming. Thank you for your understanding.

An Important Note for 2018 Eisteddfod Competitors

The New APFA, AMCOS, ARIA and PPCA 'Blanket Licensing Rule' is continuing in 2018. It will cover the use of copyright music and sound recording at all Eisteddfods throughout Australia

The new licensing scheme means that a set fee will be charged for each Eisteddfod entry. (An entry is defined as one person or one group entering one event). The fees collected by an Eisteddfod are paid to the licensing authority which will distribute about 85% to the songwriter's, composers and music publishers whose works are being performed. This fee has been incorporated in your entry fee, however this fee will increase over the next few years and extra increases in entry fees may apply in the future. - Finalist lists will be posted on our Facebook page at conclusion of relevant solo age sections and available at the entry door.
- All High Score Champion finals are competed on last night of Eisteddfod Wednesdav 4th Julv.
- Champions will be presented on stage at the completion of our gala evening awards Wednesday 4th July.
