Babies: You may enter more than one routine in these sections. Repeats are allowed for champs.

Specially Restricted: For competitors who have <u>not</u> won a specially restricted section of that style.

Restricted: For competitors who have won in a specially restricted section of that style.

Open: For competitors who have won in a restricted section in that style.

Pre-Professional: for advanced dancers who are 14+ undertaking a full-time dance or performing arts coarse, and are not receiving a full-time secondary education at a government or non-government school. Distance education students completing less than 30 hours of practical dance a week are eligible to enter regular sections. Evidence of Distance education details will be required in the form of a letter from the issuing department. They may not enter 15+ sections except for improvisation.

- Age Is as of 10th, March 2018. Duos/Trios age is taken from the eldest performer.
 Troupe entries are calculated at the average age of the Troupe. If 10.4 round down to 10/u and if 10.5 round up to 11and they will be 12/u.
- 2. NO Repeats will be allowed except in Babies championships, All Novice Championships, 10/u Open Championships
- 3. Music only CDs will be accepted.
 All CDs should be clearly labelled with the section number, competitor name, and competitor number. Please bring a spare copy and test your disc before you submit
- it. One track per CD.
- 4. Championships all competitors entered into championship sections must enter and compete in the normal section and improvisation of that genre to quality. LTDUC does not take responsibility for notifying those competitors not entered in the correct qualifying sections.
- 5. Injuries No responsibility will be accepted by the organisers of any injury, accident or loss of any property occurred by all persons and competitors attending the Dance Challenge
- 6. Improvisations Any plain class leotard or dance attire, including 2 piece or dance pants. No glitz. Demi-Character requires competitors to use at least two props which they may view backstage at the beginning of the session. The NEW Mystery Improvisation allows competitors to dance any style they feel suits the music played. Competitors are encouraged to take multiple shoes side stage with them, should they need to change.

- No Resin is to be used. Tarkett floor is provided and resin will cause the tarkett to become slippery.
- No Changing inside the venue, please use the changing areas provided. Under the NSW Child Protection Act, all dressing and undressing is to be done in the designated areas.
- 9. NEW Pre-Professional section For advanced dancers who are undertaking a full-time dance or performing arts coarse, and are not receiving a full-time secondary education at a government or nongovernment school. Distance education students completing less than 20 hours of practical dance a week are eligible to enter regular sections. Evidence of Distance education details will be required in the form of a letter from the issuing department.
- 10. Please use **tap covers** or remove tap shoes within the Venue.
- 11. Venue to be cleared for cleaning at the end of each session weather permitting.
- 12. Any competitor using feathers, glitter, hay or any other loose materials within their performance will need to advise backstage and sound desk prior to section and will need to supply one person to assist with sweeping the stage- STRICTLY NO POWDER TO BE USED as this causes the tarkett to become slippery and is a safety hazard to other performers.
- 13. Prompting back-stage will only be allowed in the 3/u, 4/u & 5/u Any-style sections and championships, the 6/u troupe sections and the inclusive sections

- **14.** LTDUC has the right to combine sections where necessary.
- 15. No teachers, mothers/helpers side-stage except in babies section or when props are required. However you may accompany your competitor/s to the backstage holding area

16. Arrival time

Competitors should arrive at least 30 minutes before estimated start time of Section

17. Time Limits

Troupes have a time limit of 5 minutes. Revue/Production have a maximum time limit of 10min. Duo's and Trios have a time limit of 4 min. Solo's have a time limit of 3 min.

18. Photography and Filming

No personal video- or photography will be permitted inside the venue. A professional videographer and photographer are available on the day.

19. Any protests must be lodged at the back table in writing no later than 15 minutes after the end of the section. All protests must be accompanied by a \$100.00 fee. Protests will be dealt with by the Committee. The \$100.00 fee will be forfeited if the protest is dismissed.

20. Teacher's passes

Teachers pass must be shown upon entry. These passes are not transferrable.

21. Any persons who approach the adjudicator during the festival may deem their child or studio disqualified. The Adjudicator's decision is final



During the event our directors will be looking for a Ministry of Dance summer school in Melbourne. This award is valued at \$800 and every entrant to live to dance ultimate challenge is eligible for this amazing opportunity. To be announced on last day of competition.

CHAMPIONSHIP SECTIONS

We offer both NOVICE and OPEN Championship sections. Both require you to enter the improvisation section corresponding with the style of dance you have entered to gualify and also a section of that style.

Novice Championship

Novice Championships are for competitors who have not won first place in a novice championship or placed in an open championship for the respective genre. To qualify you must have danced in a Specially Restricted, Restricted or Open section in that category and an improvisation section of that style. In the Novice Championship section you will be required to perform one routine only. Repeats are allowed.

Open Championship

To qualify you must have danced in an Open section for that category and also entered the Improvisation section for that Style.

For example: to quality for a Jazz Championship you must have entered the Open Jazz section and Jazz Improvisation section for your age group. Repeats Not Allowed.

In the Open Championship section you are required to perform the following

Jazz One improvisation followed by one Jazz routine. *no improvisation in OPEN Championship section for 10/u.

Modern/Contemporary One Improvisation followed by a Contemporary/ Modern routine. *no improvisation in OPEN championship section 10/u

Classical One Classical & one Demi-Character routine required. *one dance only for 10/u OPEN Championship.

Tap Two varying tap routines for example: Slow and Speed. *one tap routine only for 10/u OPEN Championship.

*COMPETITORS AGED 10/U WILL ONLY BE REQUIRED TO PERFORM ONE DANCE ONLY IN THE NOVICE AND OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP. REPEATS ARE ALLOWED AND COMPETITORS MAY CHOOSE TO DANCE EITHER A CLASSICAL OR DEMI IN CLASSICAL CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR THIS AGE GROUP.
