GET UP N DANCE

RULES & CONDITIONS

1. Get up n dance is open to amateur dancers only.
2. An entry form is required for each dancer. No entry is final until payment is made in FULL.
3. Program and Administration Fees are compulsory with each entry.
4. Refunds will not be considered or given if you miss your section or are unable to attend.
5. Reports will be available for collection after each section.
6. Each performance must be time limited. Time limit for each solo/duo/trio is 3 minutes. If you go over the time limit your song will be faded out.
7. Music will be on a CD or USB. Please make sure your music is cued and ready to start. One track per CD OR USB only. CD's and USB's must be clearly marked with the name of the competitor, section number and studio.
8. Ensure your studio has obtained their licence from AMCOS for the copyright of the music you have selected.
9. Props are to be placed on and off the stage in a timely manner.
10. Taps shoes are not to be worn in the hall unless covered.
11. Due to strict child protection laws there will be no dressing, hair or makeup allowed in the hall or toilets, please use change rooms provided.
12. A nominated person may video your competitor in a designated area only. If you are caught videoing anywhere else other than the designated area you could risk that competitor being disqualified.
13. All dancers perform at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for accidents, injury or loss. This includes all attendees of the eisteddfod.
14. There will be no rehearsing in the hall.
15. While dancers are on stage please do not enter or leave the hall so as not to distract. This is also a sign of respect for the dancer who is performing.
16. Dancers must be ready to perform in their designated section as shown in the program. No dancer is to dance out of section.
17. Please note that the times outlined in the program are a guide only. It is advisable though that you arrive at least 30mins prior to your section. We will be unable to wait for late dancers.
18. No prompting will be permitted. 5 years and under may have a little extra assistance.
19. Smoking and alcohol are not permitted on school grounds.
20. No communication is to be made with adjudicator at any time. The adjudicators decision will be final and no dispute entered into.
21. The organisers reserve the right to add, delete, combine or split sections as necessary. A refund shall be given if the organisers delete a section.

COVID SAFE PLAN

- ✓ Hand sanitiser must be used upon entry to the venue, as well as when entering and exiting the stage.
- ✓ Seating in the venue will be socially distanced, with the chairs being at least 1.5m apart. There will be no standing gathering allowed. Sitting or stretching on the floor is also not permitted.
- ✓ One parent/guardian per child will be allowed to attend the competition. Guests are welcome to wear masks.
- ✓ There will be one age group per session in order to limit the number of different people in the venue at one time.
- ✓ Dancers may only attend the event during their age group's session and must leave following the final adjudication.
- ✓ The hall will be closed in between each age group for cleaning. All teachers, parents/guardians and dancers are required to leave during this time.
- ✓ Studio owners will be required to provide a list of parent/guardian names and contact details prior to attending the competition. A template for this will be provided to you in advance.
- ✓ Changeroom space will be limited due to social distancing guidelines. Dancers are encouraged to arrive in costume. During the session, dancers are welcome to use the changerooms backstage, though this will depend on numbers. Dance bags may need to be stored elsewhere in order to increase changerroom space.
- ✓ Participants must reside within the Greater Western Sydney region.
- ✓ These guidelines may be altered closer to the date in order to comply with changing rules and regulations provided by the government.
- ✓ If our eisteddfod is cancelled, we will transfer all entries to online video option.
