To be eligible to enter the Scholarship Master Class competitors must have entered and performed in at least four (4) solo classes in the following categories:

Classical, Modern Contemporary, Demi-Character Jazz, Tap, Song & Dance (excludes Improvisation).

A Scholarship master class will be held with the Adjudicator, this further supports his/her knowledge of the capabilities of the performers and supports his /her choice of the recipients of the two Scholarships of \$1,000 each to be awarded.

The adjudicator will conduct the Scholarship class on the stage of the DRTCC. This class may be open to an audience.

Finalists will be chosen from this class to compete in the Scholarship Dance-off. The Dance-off will be a routine the competitor has performed in this Eisteddfod. The Adjudicator will choose the final routine for the finalists. The winners of the Scholarship will be announced at the Award Presentations at the completion of the Senior Dance program.

The purpose of the Scholarship is to contribute financial support to further studies in a major dance studio or special summer/winter school or workshops that will provide additional knowledge and further expand on already accomplished skills and training.

The winner of a scholarship will be ineligible to enter the Scholarship class for two years.

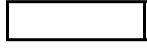
