RULES

- 1. All competitors and other persons attending sessions at the Festival do so at their own risk. By entering the Festival you agree to bound by the rules outlined this schedule and any decisions made by its executive committee.
- 2. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the correct amount of entry fee and on the official entry form. Please check your entries carefully as no missed or incorrect section entries will be added or changed in the programme only Convenor errors will be amended.
- 3. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entries and the decision of the Committee is final & binding.
- **4.** Please make all cheques, money orders or postal notes payable to "Lockyer District Dancing Festival Association Incorporated."

5. AGE DETERMINATION DATE: 1st JANUARY 2017.

- 6. In the case of a dispute arising in respect of the age of any competitor and his/her eligibility to appear in any age grouping, the committee reserves the right to require the production of a birth certificate by that competitor.
- 7. A minimum of four competitors will be accepted for groups. A competitor may appear no more than **twice** in any group section. No group consisting of identical children may appear more than once in any group section. Should this rule be breached the 2nd group will be automatically disqualified.
- 8. To be eligible for the Fay Hauser Memorial Group Trophy, a studio must have performed no less than <u>TEN</u> group items in all.
- **9.** All competitors must have "TAPS" attached to their shoes in all items where tapping is performed. Back-stage personnel have the authority to inspect all shoes.
- **10. SOLOS:** Males over the age of eight (8) years are not permitted to use female dressing rooms (due to privacy rights). A separate Male change area will be allocated. Persons requiring special consideration regarding dressing areas are asked to contact the Convenor.
- **11.** Competitors must appear in the order in which they appear in the programme. Under no circumstances will a competitor be allowed to appear out of section without permission from the Convenor. Extreme circumstances will be at the Convenor's discretion.
- **12.** No communication whatsoever is permitted with the adjudicator prior to the completion of the Festival. This rule applies equally to competitors, teachers, parents, friends or other interested parties. The committee may consider disqualification of any competitor involved in a breach of this rule.
- **13.** All items will have time limits and be monitored by the Adjudicator. Time limits which include entries and exits are MAXIMUM TIME LIMITS. Please be aware that any characterisation before or after routines, that is performed without music, is classed as performing and will be timed. If this rule is broken points will be deducted at the Adjudicators discretion.
- **14.** The Adjudicator's decision is final in all sections and he or she has the power to withhold or divide prizes according to merit. The Convenor or Committee shall not enter into any discussion contrary to this.
- **15.** If insufficient entries are received in a particular item, the committee reserves the right to cancel such item or should it be necessary, to combine items. The committee may also separate any items, at their discretion, where there are an excessive number of entries.
- 16. Unisex dressing rooms are available on group weekend for all participants of the groups to use, and competitors accompanied by supervising males. Anyone requiring special consideration or the use of the unisex dressing rooms must notify the Convenor. Photography and/or videoing is prohibited in dressing rooms.

- **17.** Please state all competitor names on one entry form only for Duo or Trio items. Entry will not be accepted unless names of all competitors are submitted together at the same time, with full payment, date of birth of all competitors and RELEASE & INDEMNITY SIGNED for all competitors.
- 18. No routine to be performed more than once. Change of costume or music does not constitute change of routine.
- **19.** Competitors in championships must appear in the order in which they are programmed and under no circumstances will they be allowed to dance out of order.

Competitors must dance and receive a score in the following sections to qualify:-BALLET CHAMPIONSHIP - Classical Solo & Demi-Character TAP CHAMPIONSHIP – Solo Tap, Waltz Tap & Speed Tap MODERN CHAMPIONSHIP – Up-Tempo Jazz & Slow Modern/Neo Classical or Contemporary SONG & DANCE CHAMPIONSHIP – Song & Dance Tap or Song & Dance Ex Tap Section Dances CANNOT be repeated in Championships

- **20.** When determining the age aggregates, scores from championships, novice, choreography and improvisation items will not be included. All other items are included.
- **21.** Only officials and stagehands allowed side stage / in the wings during performances. One Supporter only, whether it is a Teacher, Parent or Friend is allowed side stage for 9 years & under Solo Items. The exception for 10 years and over will be, if props are required in the Demi-Character or Song & Dances Sections. Only one person per group will be allowed side stage for group sections. Front stage steps only to be used during group weekend, at the teacher's discretion. Backstage Personnel have the right to remove any persons who breach this Rule. This rule will be strictly upheld.
- **22.** No voice accompaniment allowed during song and dance. All Song and Dance items will be closely monitored for voice accompaniment during the song section. If this rule is breached, points will be awarded for the dance only.
- 23. No character allowed in any tap genre unless stated otherwise.
- 24. No prompting from side stage or audience, of competitors while performing on stage.
- 25. Adjudication sheets can be obtained from the Convenor's table 10 minutes after conclusion of an item.
- **26.** Competitors who stop during a performance and leave the stage may re-appear for comments only. No mark or place will be awarded. The exception being 6 years & under who can re-appear and be marked or placed at the Adjudicators discretion. Any decisions made by the adjudicator in relation to a performer not completing their performance due to technical difficulties will be final.
- **27.** Only Amateur competitors eligible for competition at the Eisteddfod. "Amateurs" being not Professional Performers who derive an income from the Art of Dance or who are under contract, whether part-time or full-time to a Professional Dance Company.
- 28. A competitor may appear only once in any Duo or Trio age sections and Choreography sections.
- 29. A Tape/Ipod/CD deck will be provided for use by all teachers and parents. No private Ipod/Tape/CD decks allowed.
- 30. The committee reserves the right to substitute an adjudicator should this become necessary.
- **31.** No tap shoes to be worn in the hall unless covered. Costumes to be covered at all times other than on side stage.
- **32.** All competitors are requested to register on the programme placed side stage and report to the conductor of Sessions, one section before commencement of their item. If not it will be assumed that the competitor is not competing. Should a registered competitor need to be called or miss their order of performance they will be automatically disqualified.
- **33.** Solo/Duo/Trio competitors may enter their own age group only in all sections, other than where dual age sections apply, as stated in the schedule. No solo/duo/trio competitor will be allowed to dance up an age group.

- 34. Trampolines or springboards are not legitimate equipment for acrobatical sections.
- **35.** The committee shall decide on any matter not covered by these rules and its decision on any question or dispute shall be final.
- **36.** Children must be kept still and quiet during performances. Parents this is your responsibility. Parents or Guardians of noisy, unruly children will be asked to remove them from the hall.
- **37.** Any Teacher/Parent or Dancer displaying bad sportsmanship in any way, shape or form, will be disqualified and asked to leave immediately.
- **38.** In the interests of fairness, performers who have had professional contact with the adjudicator during a period of 6 months prior to the Eisteddfod are not eligible to compete. Entry fees will be refunded should this be the case. Should you not show all honesty to this rule, you may be disqualified.
- **39.** Entry Fees are <u>NOT REFUNDABLE</u> under any circumstances. Submitting an Entry Form for the Lockyer District Dancing Festival, confirms your acceptance that Solo's, Championships, Bursaries, Choreographies or Duo/Trio Items can be scheduled at anytime, during the advertised start and finish dates. Due to the large number of entries, requests for specific days cannot be taken into consideration.
- **40.** All persons entering the Hall must secure an entry ticket before admittance is allowed. Door volunteers and the committee have the right to request the sighting of an entry ticket and ask any persons to leave who cannot produce a current session ticket.
- **41.** Private videotaping or still photography is not allowed. There will be professional videotaping and photographers in house during the course of the Festival.
- **42.** A separate entry form is required for each solo competitor. The Sound System Fee is payable per solo competitor. Entries listing more than one competitor will not be accepted. Groups and Duo/Trio entries are to complete a different entry form to solo competitors.
- **43.** The committee shall not be responsible for any infringement of copyright or royalty by individual performers or persons associated with the performance.
- **44.** Duplication of the Eisteddfod Programme is prohibited, being the property of "The Lockyer District Dancing Festival Association Incorporated".

Most Outstanding Tap Dancer: Any Age. Must compete in Tap Solo, Waltz Tap & Speed Tap. Will be chosen by the Adjudicator. Proudly sponsored by Melanie Thomas

Most Promising Song & Dance Trophy: 12 years and under and 13 years and over. Will be chosen by the Adjudicator.

Most Promising Up-Tempo Jazz Dancer Trophy: 12years and under and 13 years and over. Will be chosen by Adjudicator.

Most Promising Neo-Classical/Slow Modern Dancer Trophy: 12 years and under and 13 years and over. Will be chosen by the Adjudicator.

Most Promising Contemporary Dancer Trophy: 12 years and under and 13 years and over. Will be chosen by the Adjudicator.

Lockyer District Bursary:	Junior (12 years & under) - \$50; Trophy & Certificate.
	Senior (13 years & over) - \$100; Trophy & Certificate.

Awarded to a local competitor, who attends a local studio in the Lockyer District, who participated in solos as well as groups for an eligible studio. To be eligible a competitor must have performed in four or more solo items and four or more groups for the same studio. The Bursary is awarded to the competitor with the highest points gained over four solo performances, excluding championships. Should there be a tie, the highest five marks will be added.

Lockyer Valley Regional Council Bursary: \$100 & Trophy. Will be chosen by Adjudicator. Awarded to the **Most Outstanding All Round Performer** of the Festival. To be eligible a Competitor must have performed in **6 or more Solo items (excluding Championships)**.

The Fay Hauser Memorial Trophy: Perpetual Trophy to winner & Replica Trophies to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd. A Perpetual Trophy to be awarded annually to the dance studio accumulating the most points in group sections. To be eligible a studio must have performed in no less than TEN group items in all. Total points acquired by each studio to be divided by the number of groups that have competed from their studio.

Lockyer District Dancing Festival Scholarship: Trophy, Scholarship & Certificate This award recipient is chosen by the adjudicator as the most promising local competitor **any age**. The award is intended to assist the local competitor to further their dance study through study in extra classes or summer school/vacation intensive to the value of \$500. *Recipient must attend a local dance school and compete exclusively for a local dance school, in both the solo and group competition at the festival.

- No costumes allowed. No props to be used. GIRLS: must wear non-adorned, solid colour class attire and dance shoes. No logos, sequins, glitter or sparkles. No accessories in hair. BOYS: Standard Exam attire to be worn.
- 3. Entries will be received on the official entry form. Entry fee will be the same as normal sections. Any form of dance may be performed in the Choreography Section ie. Classical, Modern or Tap. NO SONG & DANCE ALLOWED.
