Levels available: **Specially Restricted (SR) / Restricted (R) / Open (O)**

- SR** for competitors who have never placed in the given genre at any competition.
NEW ROUTINES DO NOT GO BACK TO SPECIALLY RESTRICTED!
- R** for competitors who have placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in specially restricted, in the given genre but have not placed 1st previously in a restricted section at any competition.
- O** for competitors how have previously placed 1st in the given genre at any competition.

What is it? All dancers who receive 1st place in a solo or duo section will be invited back to compete their solo again in the ITSDC Invitational. The dancer will receive an invite when they receive their report/award. The parent must then register and pay of their dancer to attend.

Section Dancers will compete in age group sections (not styles). All performers will receive an ITSDC Invitational award, and places will be given for 1st, 2nd & special awards, with first place receiving the age group Title Award.

2019 Guidelines

Thank you for choosing to join 'In the Spotlight Dance Challenge,' in entering this competition you are agreeing to the following rules, guidelines and disclaimer.

- General** The committee reserves the right to amend, separate and/or join any section as they see fit. The committee will make the final discussion on anything not covered in these rules. This competition is open to amateurs only. If any rules set out in this syllabus are not adhered to, the committee has the right to disqualify the competitor/s. All entries and payments must be put through via www.comps-online.com.au All choreography and performances must comply with safe dance practices, as well as age appropriate music and costuming. Prompting is ONLY allowed for 5/under sections if required. A competitor can only compete once per section. Repeated dances due to run offs or forgetting a dance is at the discretion of the adjudicator and committee.
- Age Groups** All competitors MUST be entered into the correct age groups, as outlined in the syllabus. Proof of age must be supplied if requested by the committee. Troupes are based on average ages from 1st January 2019.
- Arrival** We advise that all competitors arrive approximately one hour prior to their section, to avoid missing their section.
- Adjudication** The adjudicator's decision is final. Under no circumstances can a competitor and/or parent approach the adjudicator at any time of the competition. All prizes and results will be announced at the completion of each section. The committee can change the adjudicator at last minute and/or without notice.
- Music** All music must be provided on a labelled CD. A separate CD is required per dance. Music is to be handed into the music station prior to the section commencing. All competitors and teachers are responsible for having their own music license with APRA/AMOS. All CDs must be collected after each section.
- Props** Props can be used and are welcome at "In the Spotlight Dance Challenge," however they must be safe and in good working order. The prop must be free of glass or dangerous materials that could cause harm or injury to any competitor/spectator. It is the responsibility of the prop owner to place the prop on and off stage and also remove any mess created. NO props to be left backstage or left in the hall for long periods of time after the completion of the child's routine.
- Venue Usage** All competitors and guests must respect the venue and its facilities.
- Photography** In line with The Child Protection Act, NO photography or videoing is allowed in any change room or during any on stage performance. Photography and videoing may lead to disqualification. The committee has a permission to publish general images taken at the event.
- Improvisations** Will be available in jazz, tap, hip hop, lyrical, Broadway and variety. A plain leotard for girls and plain dancewear for boys can be worn, no costumes, no glitz or studio apparel.
- Program** A program will be emailed to all entrants prior to the commencement of the competition. If you do not receive your program, it is your responsibility to contact In the Spotlight Dance Challenge. No refunds can be provided for any reason, apart from the cancellation of a section by the committee. Please ensure you enter the correct sections as no changes can be made to the program once emailed. Age groups will be on the same day where possible.
