ECC– Rules and Information

GENERAL INFORMATION

Entries close: 9th Aug unless sold out prior

ECC is a competition that presents students with the opportunity to showcase their own choreography. Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, as well as HM and special awards for each age group.

Music is to be dropped off and picked up from the check in point, where competitors check in at least **30 minutes prior to the start of their section.** Crit sheets will also be available from check in after the section is complete.

There is an audience entry fee for this competition of 12.50 p/p (5yrs and under fee) There will be NO eftpos or credit card facilities at the venue.

There will be canteen available on the day.

RULES

- Each routine must be no longer than 2 minutes or the competitor will incur a 5 point deduction.
- Music, choreography and costumes must all be suitable for a family audience or a 5 point deduction will occur.
- All routines must be 100% student work, with no input from teachers or parents
- Tights must be worn for all items.
- No contact is to be made with the adjudicator at any time.
- Music is to be presented on a single track CD, and back up music on a USB both clearly labelled.
- No refunds will be issued after entry.
- No late entries will be accepted.
- No telephone or email entries will be accepted.
- Entries will not be accepted until full payment has been received.
- Age is taken as of 1st Jan 2018.

MUSIC

- -CDs must be provided on a standard CD (not rewritable).
- CDs should be clear of any scratches and burnt at a low speed (x16 writing speed). Failure to do so may result in the music being unable to play.
- CDs must be clearly labelled with the student's name and category.
- If the music is faulty and no back up music has been provided, competitors will have the option to dance without music at the end of the section they will not be disqualified.
