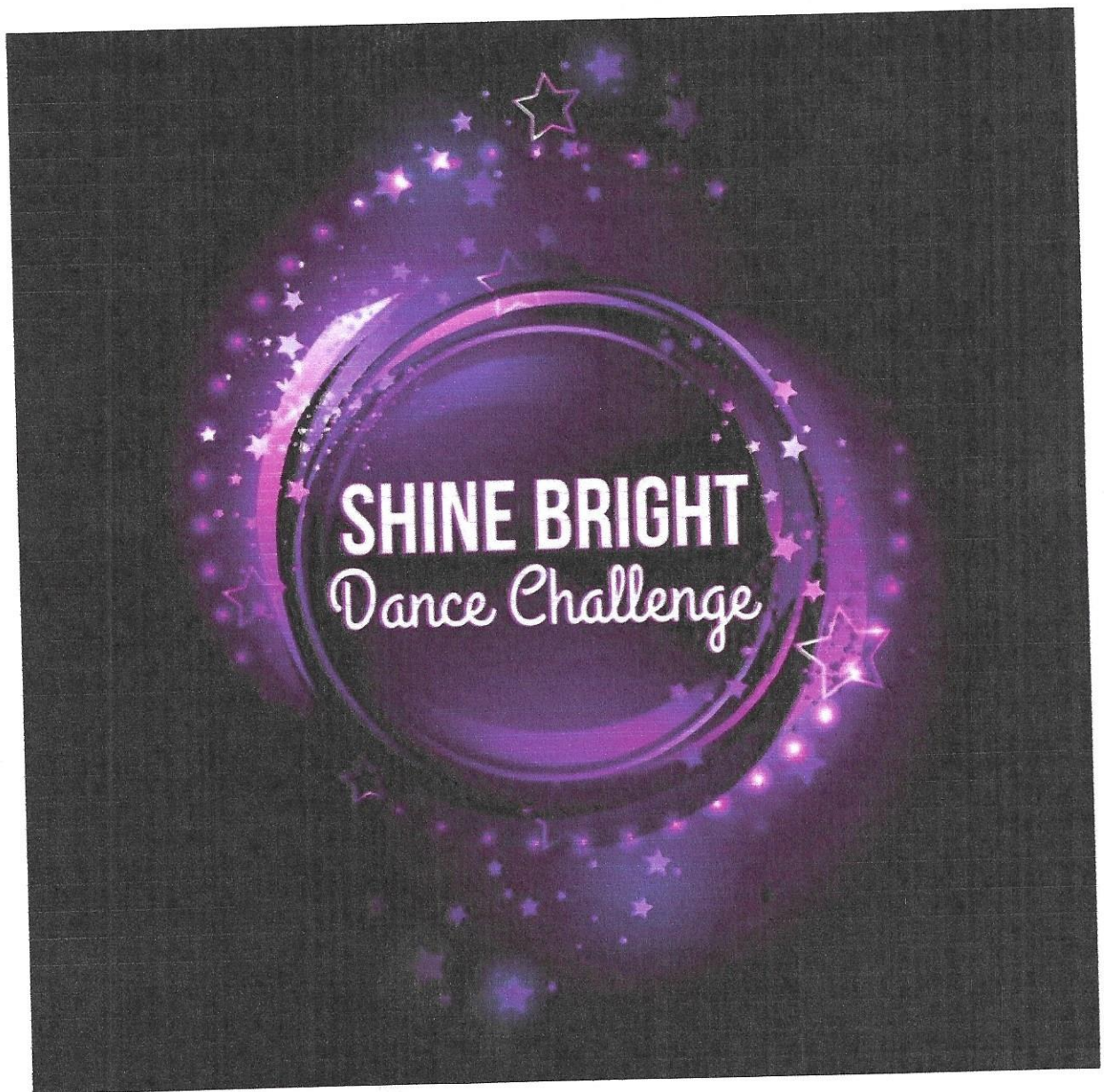

(All competitors are free)

COVID RULES: All Adults over 16 years must be fully vaccinated and masks must be worn at all times by everyone over 12 years of age

Cleaning will take part in all breaks therefore you will be asked to leave the hall

QR check in or manual check in is a must

RULES:

- SOLOS/ DUOS /TRIOS -**AGE AT THE FIRST DAY OF CHALLENGE** (12th MAR 2022) all dancers must dance in their correct age sections
- Dancers who train more than 13hrs per week must dance in **ADVANCED**
- TROUPES – **AVERAGE AGE AS AT THE FIRST DAY OF CHALLENGE** (12th Mar)
- All dancers / competitors compete at their own risk. Shine Bright Dance Challenge takes **NO** responsibility for any accidents, injury, or death to any persons associated with the eisteddfod, either as a competitor, volunteer, or a member of the public, at any time.
- The adjudicators decision is final... any teachers, parents and or competitors approaching the adjudicator will be disqualified and asked to leave the venue
- All competitors / parents give their permission for photos to be used by Shine Bright Dance Challenge for promotional material, this includes results etc. on social media
- **NO** videoing or photography is allowed from the audience. If caught doing so you will be asked to leave the venue.
- **NO REFUNDS – transfer may be offered**
- Due to child protection laws please use the change rooms provided, **NO** changing in the main hall.
- **NO** practising in the hall
- Event is an Alcohol FREE zone
- Tap shoes are to be covered
- Nobody to be back stage except competitors and carers of babies under 5's and also under 6's, unless helping with props
- No resin to be used
- All programs will be uploaded to social media and emailed unless other arrangements have been made
- Music is via USB (preferred) or CD's and are to be labelled with your child's name and marked if they start on or off the stage
- Spare copies of CD's is a great idea
- Sections may be combined if needed due to lack of entries but adjudicated according to the level
- Music is to be relevant to the age of the performer
- Plain Leotard / crop top and bottoms to be worn for Impros
- Copy of child's birth certificate required on entry
- Prompting will not be permitted except for in the babies sections
- Impros will be danced in age sections only
- All competitors must perform in order of programme
- There is to be quiet in the hall at all times
- No dancer is to perform out of section

- Shine Bright Dance Challenge reserves the right to change competition days or move location due to unforeseen circumstances
- Song and Dance routines – **NO** vocals allowed during singing sections
- Time Limits: Babies (U5) – 2.5mins, Solos – 3mins, Troupes 5mins
- Troupes – SMALL or LARGE (small up to 9 dancers Large 10 plus)
- In the event changes / cancellations need to be made due to covid transfers will be offered to a later comp and will be valid for 18months
- **Covid 19 rules to be followed at all times**
- **Depending on the status of the covid situation will depend on how many people can attend and how the running of the comp will go ahead**
- **For the health and safety of all attending as well as staff and conditions of venue hire everyone over the age of 16yrs will need to be fully vaccinated with a covid 19 vaccine**

SOLO SECTION DEFINITIONS:

- **Specially Restricted** – For competitors who have never won that style of dance at any competitions
- **Restricted** – For competitors who have not won restricted in that style but have won in the specially restricted for that style (babies sections are not taken into count)
- **Open** – for competitors who have won specially restricted and restricted for that style. Or for competitors who dance more than 13hours per week
- **Advanced** – For students who take are part time or full time dancers and or dance / train more than 13hrs per week

DANCE

SECTIONS:

- **Babies – Under 4's – Any Style**
- **Babies – Under 5's – Any Style** (section maybe spilt into styles depending on entries)

Jazz, Tap, Lyrical / Contemp, Classical, Song & dance, Demi Character, Hip Hop

(No more than 3 dances in the section from the one competitor. However welcome to enter additional dances in the under 6yrs sections)

- **Under 6,7, 8,9,10,11,12,13,14, 15-18yrs and 18yrs Over**

6 yrs, 8yrs, 10yrs, 12yrs, 14yrs, over 15yrs

JAZZ, LYRICAL, CONTEMP, CLASSICAL, TAP

- All ages can repeat
- 8yrs and above must enter an impro in the same style as solo to enter that style championships

(Trophies for all placings)

SCHOLARSHIPS

Performer nominates 2 dances where the scores will be added together. The Highest score wins a cash Prize aswell as entry fee money to next comp (how much depends on entries) plus a Trophy.

- Pre Jnr Scholarship – 5/u, 6/u and 8/U
- Jnr Scholarship – 10/U and 12/U
- Snr Scholarship – 14/U and 15/O

DUO'S / TRIO'S

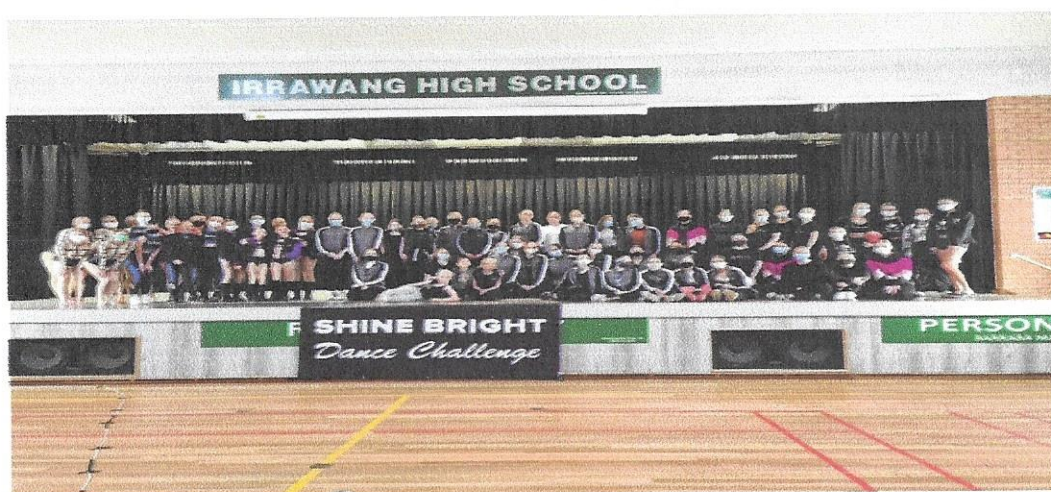
Any Style – under 5, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14 and 15 years and over

TROUPES

- Troupes can be entered as novice troupes if the following applies... please write this on form below when emailing entry or be sure to select novice troupes when doing via comps online

Novice Troupes/ Beginners –

Troupes that are made up of all students new to competing (are in a performance / beginners class at studio) and have not competed in troupes for more than 12mths... The troupe also must not have been competing altogether for more than 12months. **NO ELITE** dancers can be in the Novice troupes
