DUOS/TRIOS: \$60

ADMIN / PROGRAM FEE : \$10

Competitors Fee : \$39.00

(no spectators fee on the day)

RULES:

- **AGE AT THE FIRST DAY OF THE MONTH OF THE COMP**- 1st MARCH 2025
- All dancers must dance in their correct age sections
- You must enter the style of dance you have qualified in at the current level you are in, example – you qualified in R JAZZ but since have moved up to OPEN JAZZ you must enter OPEN JAZZ
- All dancers / competitors compete at their own risk. Shine Bright Dance Challenge takes **NO** responsibility for any accidents, injury, or death to any persons associated with the eisteddfod, either as a competitor, volunteer, or a member of the public, at any time.
- The adjudicators decision is final... any teachers, parents and or competitors approaching the adjudicator will be disqualified and asked to leave the venue
- All competitors / parents give their permission for photos to be used by Shine Bright Dance Challenge for promotional material, this includes results etc. on social media
- **NO** videoing or photography is allowed from the audience. If caught doing so you will be asked to leave the venue.
- **NO REFUNDS**
- Due to child protection laws please use the change rooms provided.
- **NO** practising in the hall
- Event is an Alcohol FREE zone
- Tap shoes are to be covered
- Nobody to be back stage except competitors and carers of babies under 4's under 5's and also under 6's.
- No resin to be used
- All programs will be uploaded to social media and emailed unless other arrangements have been made
- Music is via Music Uploads (www.musicuploads.com.au) (NOT OPEN YET)
- Spare copies on USB is a great idea as a back up
- Music is to be relevant to the age of the performer
- Prompting will not be permitted except for in the babies sections
- All competitors must perform in order of programme
- There is to be quiet at all times
- No dancer is to perform out of section
- Unfinished dances may be repeated at the discretion of the adjudicator except 12yrs and over.
- Shine Bright Dance Challenge reserves the right to change competition days or move location due to unforeseen circumstances
- Song and Dance routines – **NO** vocals allowed during singing sections
- Time Limits: Babies (U5) – 2.5mins, Solos – 3mins,
- Covid 19 rules to be followed at all times

- Previous championship overall winners can compete in sections but are not eligible to compete for State Championship- Top 10 (they are invited to perform a hand over dance)

SOLO SECTION DEFINITIONS:

- **Tiny Tots / Babies Performance** – For competitors 6years and under (includes 4s and 5 yr olds)
- **PERFORMANCE - Specially Restricted / Restricted** – for those competitors that have placed / won in Specially Restricted and have only place 2nd or 3rd in Restricted
- **ELITE – Open/ Advance** – for competitors who have won restricted and or have placed 2nd or 3rd in Opens for that style. Or for competitors who dance more than 13hours per week or attend dance / acro training or private coaching during school hours throughout the week.



SECTIONS:

- **Tiny Tots** – dancers 6years and under
- **Pre-Juniors** – dancers 7yrs and 8yrs
- **Juniors** – dancers 9yrs and 10yrs
- **Pre-Teens** – dancers 11yrs and 12yrs
- **Teens-** dancers 13yrs and 14yrs
- **Seniors** – dancers 15yrs and OVER

(dancers will compete in their age group – 7s, or 8s etc but overall awards will be combined as above)

ALL DANCERS IN EVERY SECTION WHO DIDN'T PLACE 1ST 2ND OR 3RD will still be awarded with a participation certificate and/ or ribbon (star award)

PRESENTATION:

Presentation of all adjudications will take place at the end of the day (you are welcome to leave and come back – presentation times will be on the program for each day)

The presentation of the sections will take place first followed by the special awards followed by the announcement of the Top 10 highest point scorers.

Once the top 10 have been announced out of them the top 5 will be announced and asked to re dance the dance they received the highest score for.

The top 5 will be adjudicated again where a runner up and winner will be announced.

The announcement of the runner up and winner will take place once last years winner has performed a hand over dance
