Rules and regulations

- 1. Sections are only open to amateurs
- 2. Entries must be accompanied by fees.
- 3. Programs must be purchased with entries and will be available on the day.
- 4. Entry Forms must be fully completed
- 5. Troupe time limits: 5 minutes
- 6. Reports can be collected upon the conclusion of the Judges adjudication for that section
- 7. A point deduction will be incurred for any routines over the time frame
- 8. Props are to be removed immediately from the stage. No props are to be stored at the competition.
- 9. Cd's only will be accepted. Please ensure that there is one song per cd. Each Cd must be clearly labelled with the studio name as well as the section number
- 10. Tap shoes are only permitted on the stage
- 11. No rehearsing in the hall
- 12. Smoking is not permitted on the grounds of the school
- 13. All competitors perform at their own risk. Responsibility will not be accepted for accidents, injury or loss or damage to property. This includes all persons attending the eisteddfod.
- 14. No communication Is to be made with the adjudicator at anytime prior to or after a section.
- 15. The adjudicator's decision is always final. The adjudicator may withhold or reduce the number of prizes when the adjudicator's opinion and adequate standard is reached.
- 16. Only the listed Principal and one teacher of participating studios will be allowed free admission. Please sign in at the front door and carry appropriate ID.
- 17. All protests must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the section. Each protest must be accompanied by a fee of \$30.00 which will be forfeited if the protest is dismissed.
- 18. The committee reserves the right to delete, combine or split sections as necessary
- 19. No refund on money is allowed if the entrant is unable to attend the section on the nominated day.
- 20. No dressing, hair or make up is to be done in the bathrooms. Please use the dressing rooms provided behind the stage.
- 21. No prompting will be permitted other than in the 6/u sections. Prompting can lead to disqualification
- 22. Competitors must be ready to take the stage at the nominated times and in the order set in the program. Failure to do so may lead to disqualification. No studio is to dance out of section.
- 23. Section times given on the program are approximates only. Please ensure that competitors arrive dressed and ready to perform at least 45 minutes prior to their given time as we will continue to run up to 30 minutes early if we happen to be ahead of time. We will not wait for any late competitors.

24. Age of competition will be taken at the 1st January 2019 with 2 allowed 1 year older to keep troupes together. Please ensure that you have copies of birth certificates with you on the day. Failure to do so may result in the troupe being disqualified.
