TALENT TRIBE SECTIONS

<u>CHIEF</u>

Limited to competitors who HAVE won a 1st prize at any Eisteddfod, Dance Festival or Dance Competition in that category.

WARRIOR

Limited to competitors who have NEVER won a 1st prize at any Eisteddfod, Dance Festival or Dance Competition in that category.

TALENT TRIBE STYLES

CONTEMPORARY - A routine that combines both lyrical and modern movements.

LYRICAL - A routine that is performed to the lyrics or mood of the music.

JAZZ - A routine that utilizes jazz technique such as splits, isolation, leaps, etc.

HIP HOP - A dance that consists of the latest street dance style, as seen in current dance videos.

BROADWAY/MUSICAL THEATRE – Any style of dance interpreting a song from Broadway, movie or musical.

ACROBATICS - A routine that contains primarily gymnastic tricks, including, but not limited to walkover, front/back limbers, handstands, headstands, cartwheels, etc. There should be a blend of gymnastics and dance together.

SONG and DANCE - A routine that combines dancing and singing. This is a vocal routine...lead vocals may not be lip synched and may have back up vocal accompaniment only

BALLET: Classical & Demi-Character - A routine consisting of classical steps & ballet technique. Ballet shoes must be worn

OPEN: Any style - A routine that is a combination of any of the other categories; a routine that does not exactly fit any of the definitions of any other category.

TAP: Fast and slow - A routine utilizing tap technique and must be performed with tap shoes only

STUDENT CHOREOGRAPHY: 10u, 12u, 14u, 15o - Must be produced by the student with no teacher assistance.

IMPROVISATION: Lyrical, Jazz, Contemporary, Hip Hop – Dance wear to be worn

1) Entrants must submit a photograph in front of the official Frilledneck Fashion/Talent Tribe pull up banner at any of our Australian Talent Tribe Regionals, wearing the current Frilledneck Fashion wear you can use your own photographic equipment ie iPhone for the picture

2) Entry fee to the competition is via the Talent Tribe store for \$25 AUD. You must email your purchase receipt with your photo.

3) COMPETITION ENTITY: FRILLEDNECK FASHION is the sponsor of "Miss Frilledneck" (the "Competition"). Talent Tribe is the Australian Promoter of the event and does not have any part of the judging process.

4) ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible to enter the Competition, (1) you must be female, (2) a minimum of 4 years of age and a maximum of 15 years of age. Age as at January 1st 2020 3) you must be a legal resident of Australia (4) must be a participant of the Talent Tribe Regionals

Frilledneck Fashion reserves the right to disqualify any Entrant whose image is published during the course of the Competition in any media (publications, World Wide Web, television, etc.), that in Frilledneck Fashion' sole discretion shall be deemed to compete with Frilledneck Fashion, any and all Frilledneck Fashion brand extensions, or the Competition.

THE ENTRY PERIOD AND HOW TO ENTER:

An Entrant or Entrant's legal guardian may submit her entry form and photographs using the procedures described below at any time during the period from March 3rd to September 17th 2020 at 5pm Sydney time (the "Entry Period"). Late entries shall be ineligible. Date of entry during the Entry

Period will not affect chances of being chosen.

Semi Finalists

Semi-finalist will be announced by September 21st and will be required to submit to Frilledneck Fashion direct a head shot photo no later than September 24th All photos must be at least 500 K in size. Entrants or legal guardian of Entrants must retain the original photographs, as Semi-Finalists may be required to submit the Submitted Photographs in greater resolution.

Semi-finalists chosen will be required to be present at Talent Tribe Nationals at their own travel expense, for final judging and any photo shoots that they could be part of if they are selected as a grand finalist.

If you are chosen as a finalist, NO photographs taken prior to December 1st 2019, non-colour photographs, or photographs containing more than one person will be eligible, No enhanced or altered photographs will be eligible. While Entrants may have assistance in entering data and uploading the photos, each Entrant must otherwise complete the entry form herself.

Frilledneck Fashion reserves the right, at any stage of the Competition, to contact any Entrant or legal guardian of entrant to request resubmission of one or more of the Submitted Photographs and/or, for Semi-Finalists, the Submitted Video (including, but not limited to, in a different format than originally provided), and/or to request that the Entrant submit additional photos and/or videos (the "Additional Materials"), in Frilledneck Fashion sole discretion.

SELECTION: Selection of Semi-Finalists: Frilledneck Fashion will, in its sole discretion, select among the Entrants a group of Semi-Finalists based upon Frilledneck Fashion's evaluation of the Entrants' attractiveness and photogenic qualities (60%) and the quality of the Submitted Photographs and the Additional Materials, if any (40%). TALENT TRIBE RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1. **WARRIOR**: Limited to competitors who have NEVER won a 1st prize at any Eisteddfod, Dance Festival or Dance Competition in that category
- 2. **CHIEF**: Limited to competitors who HAVE won a 1st prize at any Eisteddfod, Dance Festival or Dance Competition in that Category
- 3. **AGE**:1st January 2020. Date of birth must be provided on request
- 4. **CLOSING DATE**: Specified via comps online.
- 5. There are no refunds, except if a section or the event is cancelled
- All competitors and spectators enter at their own risk. No responsibility will be taken for any accident, injury, or loss of property. This also applies to cars parked in the grounds of the venue.
- 7. All competitors will be required to confirm their attendance with the backstage manager. Competitors should arrive at least 30 minutes before their section
- 8. Any protests must be presented to the organiser at the front desk within 30 minutes
- 9. Adjudicators decision is final. There is to be no communication with the adjudicator except for the official committee.
- 10. Any section containing more than 20 competitors may be divided into parts A and B depending on the number in attendance on the day
- 11. If insufficient numbers in a section, the committee reserves the right to amend, combine, or cancel sections at their discretion
- 12. Changes to the running order of the program will be left to the discretion of the organiser.
- 13. Distractions and prompting from the sides of the stage will not be tolerated whilst a competitor is performing with the exception of the babies dance sections. This will lead to disqualification
- 14. Any competitor who has a memory lapse will be able to return to the stage to perform the routine once again for comments only
- 15. Members of duos/trios can only dance in one age group with the same partner, but can dance in the same section with a different partner
- 16. Competitors must only enter and compete once in a section. A change of costume or routine does not alter this rule
- 17. No competitor is permitted to wear tap shoes inside the venue. This rule will be strictly enforced
- 18. Props must be removed from stage as soon as possible after performance is completed and removed completely from side stage
- 19. Pointe shoes are not to be worn by competitors under 12 years of age

- 20. The use of videos, cameras and mobile phone photography is STRICTLY NOT PERMITTED and may lead to a competitor being disqualified. Teachers, please advise parents of this restriction. An official photographer and videographer will be available to record your dances for a fee
- 21. It is advised that change rooms be used at all times. Separate girls and boys change rooms will be available.
- 22. All rubbish and items must be removed from the venue and change rooms when you leave. Please leave change rooms and hall in the clean and tidy condition in which they were found
- 23. No smoking is permitted anywhere on school grounds
- 24. The TALENT TRIBE Committee shall decide on any matter not covered by these rules, and its decision in any question or dispute shall be final. Any rule may be amended at the discretion of the committee
- 25. By entering into the competition, you agree to comply with all the rules laid down by the Committee
- 26. Talent Tribe has the right to refuse entry to any competitor or competitor's representative who behaves in an unacceptable manner.
