INSTRUMENTAL SPECIAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with the general rules available on our website www.coffseisteddfod.org.au.

- 1. A separate copy of the music selection of each competitor must be provided for the adjudicator. Music must be clearly marked with the competitor name, section number and competitor number and handed to the librarian 20 minutes PRIOR to the commencement of the session.
- 2. A copy of the **COPYRIGHT DECLARATION FORM** must be completed. This is available at www.coffseisteddfod.org.au.
- 3. Any photocopied material will be retained by the committee to be destroyed according to copyright ruling.
- 4. All Competitors entering the Championship section must perform in two (2) other sections in their age group. That is three (3) sections altogether including the championship. Competitors may only enter in one (1) Championship section.
- 5. ACCOMPANIST- The accompanist for the instrumental section may be live piano or an instrumental backing track.
- 6. All music is to be uploaded to "Music Uploads" (there will be no CD/MP3/iphones)
- 7. No accompaniment or teacher instrumental participation is allowed in Duets, Trios, Quartets or Ensembles. A teacher may conduct a primary school or high school instrumental ensemble.
- 8. Highest Aggregate Awards will only include solo sections and championships.
- 9. Any section with less than 3 performers can be combined at the discretion of the Organising Secretary. (ie. age groups may be combined.)
- 10. There is an expectation that all competitors and audience members will stay for the entire section. There will be no talking or unnecessary movement during performances
- 11. There is to be <u>NO</u> photography and/or filming, including the use of mobile phones, during a performance.

She has adjudicated at many Eisteddfods in Melbourne and country Victoria and presented performance Masterclasses and string pedagogy workshops in Vic and NSW

students from beginner to Diploma level, 7-80 year olds! Anna loves to share her passion for the cello and all things music with her students.
