INSTRUMENTAL SPECIAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with the general rules available on our website www.coffseisteddfod.org.au.

A separate copy of the music selection of each competitor must be provided for the adjudicator. Music must be clearly marked with the competitor's name, section number and competitor number and handed to the librarian 20 minutes PRIOR to the commencement of the session.

- 1. A copy of the **COPYRIGHT DECLARATION FORM** must be completed. This is available at www.coffseisteddfod.org.au.
- 2. Any photocopied material will be retained by the committee to be destroyed according to copyright ruling.
- 3. All Competitors entering the Championship section must perform in two (2) other sections in their age group. That is three (3) sections altogether including the championship. Competitors may only enter in one (1) Championship section.
- 4. ACCOMPANIST- The accompanist for the instrumental section should be live piano
- 5. No accompaniment or teacher instrumental participation is allowed in Duets, Trios, Quartets or Ensembles. A teacher may conduct a primary school or high school instrumental ensemble.
- 6. Any section with less than 3 performers may be combined at the discretion of the Organising Secretary. (ie. age groups may be combined.)
- 7. There is an expectation that all competitors and audience members will stay for the entire section. There will be no talking or unnecessary movement during performances
- 8. There is to be <u>NO</u> photography and/or filming, including the use of mobile phones, during a performance.

Jenny Gogolin is a highly respected educator and performer, with 40 years of experience in shaping the musical landscape of Bendigo in Regional Victoria. After relocating in 1984 as part of the Musician Teacher Pilot Project, she became a pivotal figure in the Bendigo Instrumental Music Program, where she taught woodwind instruments and inspired countless students. In 1989, Jenny became the foundation musical director of the Bendigo Colleges' Symphonic Band, nurturing young talent and cultivating a thriving musical community. Up until 2024 she has worked in both Castlemaine and Bendigo schools, tutoring and conducting a wide range of chamber music and ensembles.

A versatile performer, Jenny's career spans a wide range of musical styles, from classical to contemporary. She completed her flute studies at the Canberra School of Music with renowned teachers including Thomas Pinchoff, Margaret Crawford, and Vernon Hill. Jenny has performed with esteemed artists and ensembles, including the Australian Pops Orchestra, Barry Humphries, Victor Borge, the Sadler Wells Ballet Company, and the Australian Boys Choir.

Jenny continues her love of chamber and orchestral music, by performing as part of Duo Allegrezza (flute and guitar) and with the Bendigo Symphony Orchestra, further enriching the region's vibrant musical life.
