MUSIC: For schools using backing tracks there are two options: 1. Upload the music by **Tuesday 12th May 2026** via a link that will be sent out closer to the eisteddfod OR 2. Deliver the music via USB directly to the LifeHouse Church by Wednesday 13th May 2026. **NO MUSIC WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE 13th MAY AS LIFEHOUSE TECHNICAL STAFF REQUIRE TIME TO ARRANGE THE PLAYLIST**

COPYRIGHT: The Coffs Harbour Eisteddfod supports copyright laws. It is important that all competitors and teachers realise their responsibilities regarding laws under the Australian Copyright Act 1968. The competitor must supply the adjudicator with a photocopy of the original music. All copies will be destroyed at completion of the eisteddfod.

Choir Rules

1. Schools may not enter two choirs in the same section unless at least 50% of the students are different, ie:. No more than 50% of the same students may perform in both choirs.
2. Choirs must all perform 2 contrasting songs within a 15-minute time limit.
3. Please also refer to Coffs Harbour & District Eisteddfod General Rules # 13, in reference to: No competitor/s shall be allowed to render the same item/s with which they have previously won a first prize in any section at the Coffs Harbour and District Eisteddfod, (except Dance.) School Choirs, this rule is applicable to Choirs for **5 years**.
4. Please note due to Work, Health & Safety at Lifehouse Church, and to ensure the safety of all our students, school choirs will be limited to 85 students, per Choir.

The Eisteddfod will be held over 2 days. The order of sections will be decided once all entries have been submitted.
