## **BARBARA GORDON BURSARY**

To be eligible for Barbara Gordon Bursary, competitors must compete in a Championship as well as two (2) other sections of the own competitor's choice. Additional sections to be nominated at the time of check in on the day of competition. Nominations cannot be made after sections have been completed.

Bursaries will be awarded based on the aggregate of five (5) marks received by the competitors.
