- **Dance Troupe entry fee per Competitor per routine - \$10.00**
- **Competitor pass \$25 Per Entrant (one off cost for each competitor no matter the genre)**

Competition Day

On arrival **Studios/independent entries** will need to present themselves to the registration table where the teacher will **collect the competitor registration packs**. **Spectators tickets** will be available for purchase at the door only.

Dancers will be performing on a 12 x 12 meter Tarkett Dance Floor.

All Cheer Routines will be performed on a 9 Strip Cheer Floor. SNS will provide a separate warm up room for all Cheer Routines including a sprung tumble track.

Complimentary routine videos will be provided to all Clubs in the fortnight after the competition is complete.

Dance Teachers & Competitor Passes

Every studio will be permitted two teacher passes. Our online registration requires each entry to list the teacher(s) name affiliated with the routine. Any teacher that is not included in the initial registration may be refused entry on the day and be required to purchase a spectator ticket. Parents, studio owners/dance teachers partners and any other persons of this nature are not eligible for this entry.

Both Competitor and Teachers passes will available at the registration table.

A WWCC card will be required on the day for identification and security purposes.

Champion Dancer

Champion Dancer is an exciting addition to SNS in 2021. A dancer from the **7 & Under Age Group** and above will be crowned as the **champion dancer**.

A dancer must compete in at least three or more solo routines over the duration of the competition and their **combined top three scores** will be used to decide which dancer will be crowned.

When completing your registration online you must click the "CHAMPION DANCER" button to enter, all entries must be completed prior to the competition and no late registrations will be accepted.

ENTRIES CLOSE:

Rockingham - 01/10/2021

(no late entries will be accepted)



DANCE AGE LIMITS AND CATEGORIES:

Applicable age cutoff is 31st December 2021.

Dance age groups are as follows:

- 5 and under
- 7 and under
- 9 and under
- 11 and under
- 13 and under
- 15 and under
- 17 and over
- 18 and over

Open and Novice categories will be offered in all solo divisions. In the case that **competitors** are **against themselves** due to their age or category SNS **may combine** the dancer into another **section relevant** to the style of dance they have registered for.

OPEN CLASSIFICATION: If any dancer has won first place at any competition in the same genre prior to SNS competition entry closing, the dancer **MUST** compete in an open section.

NOVICE CLASSIFICATION: Only dancers who have not won first place at a competition in the same genre prior to SNS competition entry closing are able to enter the Novice division.

UNCLASSIFIED SECTIONS: All 5/u genres will compete in the unclassified sections. Unclassified sections do not apply to any other age group unless SNS chooses to combine sections as above.

CHEER AGE LIMITS AND CATEGORIES

Applicable age cutoff is 31 December 2021.

SNS offers all age groups as per the ASCA Age Grid. We reserve the right to combine, close or open divisions at any time leading up to the event.

INDIVIDUAL AND STUDIO ENTRIES: Individual & Studio entries are both accepted. Please note an individual entry does not include free entry for parents assisting dancers on and off stage. The parent will need to purchase a ticket at the door.

Competition Rules & Guidelines

CHEER DIVISION GUIDELINES

ALLSTAR: Teams formed for the purpose of competition or display

- Two minute minimum time requirement
- Two minute and thirty seconds maximum time limit for routine
- Entire routine may be performed to music
- May perform to a combination of cheer and music with no deduction
- No props or Poms are permitted in the cheer section
- Follows the USASF safety rules and guidelines

SCHOOL: Teams where members attend and represent the same school with their main objective to support school sports

- Two minute time requirement
- Two minute and thirty seconds maximum time limit for routine
- Props such as signs, megaphones etc are permitted
- Follows the USASF safety rules and guidelines

STUNT GROUP: maximum of 5 members

- One minute maximum routine time limit
- Entire routine must performed to music
- No props are permitted
- Follows USASF safety rules and guidelines

PARTNER STUNT: maximum of 2 members and 1 spotter

- One minute maximum routine time limit
- Entire routine must be performed to music
- No props are permitted
- Follows the USASF safety rules and guidelines

DUO / INDIVIDUAL CHEER:

- One minute maximum routine time limit
- Routine must include at least 3 jumps and running and standing tumbling skills
- Minimum of four 8 counts of dance in the routine
- Follows the USASF safety rules and guidelines

Competition Rules & Guidelines

MUSIC:

Music must be **submitted via email before the 10 days before** in MP3 format. **Changes** to music after this date will **incur a \$10.00 fee per track**.

DANCE TIME LIMITS:

Dance time limits may not **exceed 3 mins** per solo, duo, trio or quartet and **3 mins and 30 secs per troupe routine** a time violations will incur a **five point deduction** off the routines total score.

DANCE PERFORMANCE DIFFICULTIES:

If a dancer commences a dance, then **stops for any reason** other than a technical fault on behalf of SNS, then the dancer is able to dance again at the end of the section.

Dancers who **do not appear when scheduled to perform** may perform at the end of the section.

However if either of the above situations were to occur, the dancers **mark will not count** towards the top 3 in that section or towards overall awards such as champion dancer. Dancers will still receive a participation medal & report card for the section.

BACK & SIDE STAGE:

Only dancers and one allocated teacher or parent will be allowed back/side stage. Dancers who require props will need this allocated helper to take props on and off stage. **NO** additional parents, infants/toddlers or siblings are permitted to come back/side stage.

FOOD:

Food and drinks will be available to purchase at the venue, families are also encouraged to bring their own food and drink with them for a healthier option.

SEATING:

All seating is classed as general admission, which means seats are first in first served. No reservations will be made on seating. The stadium will be cleared of all competitors, coaches and spectators thirty minutes prior to the commencement of the competition. Doors will re-open and tickets will be available.

Competition Rules & Guidelines

- All teams should be supervised during all official functions by an advisor or coach.
- Coaches require proficiency before skill progression. Coaches must consider the individual, group and team skill levels with regard to proper performance level placement.
- All teams, gyms, coaches and advisors should have an emergency response plan in the event of injury.
- Soft soles shoes must be worn while competing in the cheer section. No jazz shoes and / or boots are allowed.
- Jewellery of any kind, including but not limited to ear, nose, tongue, belly button and facial rings, clear plastic jewellery, bracelets, necklaces and pins on uniforms are prohibited. Jewellery must be removed and not taped over. Exception: Medical ID tags / bracelets, uniform rhinestones, single earrings for dance sections.
- Any height increasing apparatus used to propel a competitor is prohibited.
- All props must be safely discarded out of harms way.
- There are competition breaks and intervals where competitors and audience may leave their seats.
- Teams must have at least 4 members for a small division.
- The maximum number of team members for large divisions is 32 members.
- If floor spotters are required they must be provided by the competing club and may take no part in any of the routine.
- Timing and judging of routines will begin with the first organised movements or the first note of music. Timing will end with the last note of music or when the ending motion or pose is held.
- For safety purposes we require everyone to perform their routine on the performance mat / stage / floor and deductions will be given for stepping off this space, with the exception of troupe routines in dance sections, excluding pom.
- All routines must be suitable for viewing by audiences of all ages.
- Participants may compete in more than one division as long as they abide by the age restrictions in all divisions in which they compete.
- In the event a routine is interrupted because of failure of Scream N Shouts Competition equipment, facilities etc, then the participants affected will be permitted to restart the routine from the beginning or from where the interruption commenced.
- Competition officials reserve the right to stop a performance due to an injury.
- All participants must submit a signed waiver form prior to performing. No exceptions!

Competition Rules & Guidelines

APPROACHING THE ADJUDICATORS:

If at any time the adjudicators are approached by any dancer, teacher or family member/spectator before or during the competition this will result in immediate disqualification to the dancer(s) from that particular studio or family involved.

CANCELLATION, REFUNDS & RESCHEDULING:

Any dancer withdrawing from the competition after registration and payment is complete but before entries close, will be given a 50% refund of the entry fee or a 100% credit for future SNS comps.

In the event of the competition not taking place for reasons out of SNS's control, the entrant can either accept a 50% refund, take part in an alternative online competition which will run the following month or accept a 100% credit for a future SNS comp.

Failure to adhere to competition guidelines may result in disqualification or a deduction of five points from the competitors routine in that particular session.
