Age is based on 1 January 2024. Age Categories: 7/U, 9/U, 11/U, 13/U, 15/O, 16/O. Entries Closing 31/10/2023

Levels : Open: If you have won first in that genre entered in any comp.
Pre-Open : If you haven't won first in that genre.

Solo Early Bird \$50, fr. Sept 1st \$55
Duo/ Trio EB \$40 per dancer, fr. Sept 1st \$45 per dancer. Duo and Trio compete against each other. For Duo/Trio, competitors' ages must be averaged as of the date of the competition.
Improvisation : \$30

Showstopper Championship Title: \$70 (Min. 2 entries required to qualify for championships, excluding add-ons and photogenic award). Can be a repeat routine.

Vibe 4 Charity (V4C) : \$40. You can add seamlessly to as many existing solo entries. See further information in the box below to your left.

Add-On Costume: \$25. You do not need to perform for this entry, just simply nominate which routine you want to enter for this category. You can nominate as many solos as you like (except for duo/trio & championship entries) .

Photogenic Award: \$40. Please submit photo by Nov 15th. Photos not received by the cutoff date will not be judged. No refunds provided.

WHAT IS V4C?

Vibe 4 Charity (V4C) is our annual fundraising event.

100% of the entry money is donated, allowing us to contribute to meaningful initiatives and make a difference in people's lives. Moreover, we use the fundraising event as a unique opportunity to collaborate with corporate partners who share our commitment to social responsibility. Since 2021, Vibe Dance has donated over \$130,000 to various charities. Stay tuned on our social media for updates on the charities we've supported. More information coming soon!

How it works :

- You do not need to perform for this entry, just simply nominate which routine you want to enter in this category.
- The video of your performance on the day of the competition will be sent to the judges.
- Judging will be by the children and families of the nominated charity, and be based on entertainment value.
- Winners announced within 6 weeks.

Add V4C to as many solos as you wish for an extra \$40 per entry!

ADJUDICATION & PRIZES

Solos/ Duo/Trios:
Adjudication is based on Technique, Execution & Overall Performance
Trophies 1st, 2nd, 3rd. Medals HC. Every dancer in duo or trio will receive trophies or medals if placed.

Showstopper Championship:
Adjudication is based on Entertainment , Technique & Execution. Winner of each age group will receive prizes to the value of \$200

Photogenic Award:
Winner of each age group will received a \$200 gift voucher from Europro Photography.

Other Awards:
Shout out / Judges choice/ High Point

VIBE 4 CHARITY:
Adjudication is based on Entertainment, Performance & Costume. per age group. Winner of each age group will receive prizes to the value of \$300.

Costume Runway:
The winner costume will be judged at the time of the performance, based on the design, ingenuity, fit and appropriateness. Winner of each age group will receive \$120 gift voucher from The Art of Stitches.

This event will have 2 special guest judges for all age groups!

UPLOADING OF MUSIC:

You will require a Music Uploads account (www.MUSICUPLOADS.com.au) to upload your music. Refer to our social media for regular updates. Please have a backup of all music on a USB in the correct format mp3 on the event day. Remember to check your music after you have uploaded to ensure it is correct and ready to be played. VIBE DANCE is not responsible for incorrect uploads or the quality of the music. All voice critiques will also be delivered to your account in Music Uploads.

Penalties of \$10.00 per routine will apply for any change of music after the cut-off date.

FURTHER DETAILS:

VIBE DANCE may modify or cancel events due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. Sections may be combined if entries are insufficient. Sections with over 20 entries will be split into two. Event program changes are at VIBE DANCE's discretion.

Refunds for entries are only issued for duplicates or event cancellations. A \$5.00 per solo entry fee may apply for late entries. Competitor Registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Competitors grant VIBE DANCE permission to use their photos, videos, or likeness in promotions without compensation, unless specified in writing before the event (Email: info@vibedance.com.au). Performances must follow the program sequence, with exceptions at the Backstage Manager's discretion. Competitors must check in with the Backstage Manager two sections before their scheduled performance and be ready on the side stage. Props must be mobile and supervised. Coaching is allowed only for 7/U; parents of older ages are not allowed backstage for this age group.

Competitors are responsible for their personal property and any injuries during the competition. This extends to their family, friends, and associates. By entering, competitors agree not to hold VIBE DANCE or its staff liable for any injuries or illnesses sustained while attending or performing at the event.

All TAP Dancers must ensure that the screws on their shoes are not loose as it will damage the tarket floor. Any damage to the floor and repair costs will be sent to the dancer. No Tap Shoes to be worn in the venue at all times. **Pointe Shoes** are not to be worn under the age of 12. **Student Choreography** MUST BE produced by the student without any help from teachers. Resin is not allowed.

Competitors should bring their own first aid kit, as venues may not have them. VIBE Dance does not provide first aid treatment or equipment. Children under 12 need adult supervision at all times.

Adjudicators' decisions are final; no communication is allowed. VIBE Dance reserves the right to appoint a new adjudicator should the previously confirmed adjudicator is unable to perform his/her duty on the day of the event. Awards are the responsibility of individuals and must be collected at the end of the competition. If unable to collect, nominate someone. VIBE Dance does not mail awards.

To ensure safety, privacy, and artistic integrity, no videography or photography is allowed during performances, with possible disqualification for violations. Photos are permitted during awards ceremonies. Choreography and costumes should be age-appropriate. Improvisation attire should be dance wear.

Respect the venue by keeping dressing rooms tidy and removing personal items and litter. Messy changing rooms may incur a cleaning fee (up to \$300), and damages will be charged to the responsible competitor(s) sharing in the space. Notify the Back Stage Manager immediately of existing damage upon your arrival. Smoking is prohibited in competition areas.

Certificate of birth to be provided upon request for confirmation of age.
