Payment: Entries will not be accepted until full payment is made.

Closing date for entries: ***On or before** 30 July 2025 or until capacity is reached. IMPORTANT: It is the responsibility of the intended entrants to monitor entries and closing dates. ENTRIES MAY CLOSE EARLY updates will be made via our Facebook page. We encourage all intended entrants to like and follow our page for the most up to date information.*

No late entries will be accepted *(notification of closed entries will be via the Brindabella Dance Festival Canberra Facebook page)*

Refund Policy: *Refunds will not be given unless the Committee **cancels** a section completely, or you qualify for a medical refund. Medical refunds require a doctor's certificate. A \$65 administration fee will be held, and the balance refunded.*

This event may be cancelled or modified at any time without notice. The Brindabella Dance Festival Committee will take all steps necessary to ensure that the event is compliant with rules and guidelines issued by the ACT Government leading up to and at the time of the event.

Rules:

Before completing an entry, please read the competition rules including our refund policy available on the Brindabella Dance Festival website. The rules contain information on the requirements to enter championships and definition of dance styles as per sections below.

Age:

Soloists - Age is as at first day of competition being 26th September 2025

Duo/Trio – Age is the age of the eldest performer as of 26th September 2025

Groups/Troupes – Age is the age of the eldest performer as at 1 January 2025

Date of birth must be registered at the time of entry. All competitors must be prepared to provide proof of age upon request by the Brindabella Dance Festival Committee.

Payment:

Payments to be made at time of entry via on-line entry system

Music Upload:

Must be uploaded no later than **27th August 2025**, via the on-line music upload system. Music is the responsibility of the ENTRANT. Music must be checked by the entrant and ensure they have uploaded correctly. NO Music NO dance.

Age Groups:

6 YEARS AND UNDER	Must be 6 years old or younger
8 YEARS AND UNDER	Must be 8 years old or younger
10 YEARS AND UNDER	Must be 10 years old or younger
12 YEARS AND UNDER	Must be 12 years old or younger
14 YEARS AND UNDER	Must be 14 years old or younger
15 YEARS AND OVER TROUPES	No older than 18 years old as at 1 st January 2025. The eldest dancer of a troupe in 15 & over may not be older than 19 years old by the start of the competition unless they are enrolled in year 12 or equivalent.
18 YEARS AND OLDER TROUPES	18 years or older, open to full-time dance students, mature aged dancers and armatures who have left secondary schooling and wish to compete. Majority of the team must be over 18 years old.

Open Class Award

Open Class Award: Brindabella Dance Festival is excited to bring back the open class award, where we will accept entries for an “Open Class Scholarship”.

The class will be open to ALL dancers with no prerequisites or additional performance required to participate.

From this class dancers will be assessed based on their performance and behaviour in the class setting in addition to being able to pick up the choreography and execute much like a class audition process.

The class is intended to be theatrical based however this may change. A winner and 2 runners up will be selected from this class from each age group for a scholarship award/s.

In addition to class, we intend to have tickets for sale for seating at the rear of theatre for SILENT spectating by interested parents. Spectator tickets will be available for purchase at the canteen for \$10.00 each.

This opportunity is dependant on numbers for its success and may be cancelled and refunded if quota not met. You can enter this section in comps online.



Championship Rules:

6.1 Classical Ballet Championship – 12/under, 14/under, 15/over

- To qualify, competitors must have performed in two previous Open sections, one of which must be a Classical and one other chosen from Demi-Character or National Character.
- To qualify, competitors must have performed in a ballet improvisation section.

On Championship Day:

- Competitors will be required to perform two solos a Demi-Character and then a Classical.
- Only one item may be repeated. A change of costume and/or music does not constitute a change of routine.

Classical Ballet Championship - 10/under

- To qualify, competitors must have performed in two previous Open sections, one of which must be a Classical and one other chosen from Demi-Character, Lyrical or National Character.
- To qualify, competitors must have performed in a ballet improvisation section.

On Championship Day:

- Competitors will be required to perform one solo being either a Classical, Demi-Character.
- Your championship routine can be repeated in this age group.

Classical Ballet Championship - 8/under

- To qualify, competitors must have performed in one previous Open section in either Classical Ballet, Demi-Character or Lyrical.
- To qualify, competitors must have performed in the any style improvisation section.

On Championship Day:

- Competitors will be required to perform one solo being a Classical Ballet, Demi-Character.
- Your Championship Routine can be repeated in this age group.

6.2 Tap Championship 12U, 14U & 15O

- To qualify, competitors must have performed in two previous Open sections in the categories of Slow Tap, Waltz Tap or Fast Tap.
- To qualify, competitors must have performed in a tap improvisation section.

On Championship Day:

- Competitors will be required to perform two solos, dance A being a slow or waltz routine and dance B is a fast or speed tap.
- One item may be repeated. A change of costume and/or music does not constitute a change of routine.



6.3 Jazz Championship 12U, 14U & 15O

- To qualify, competitors must have performed in two previous Open sections in the categories of Jazz, Broadway Jazz or Musical Theatre.
- To qualify, competitors must have performed in a jazz improvisation section.

On Championship Day:

- Competitors will be required to perform two solos, dance A being a Broadway Jazz and Dance B being a Straight Jazz routine.
- One item may be repeated. A change of costume and/or music does not constitute a change of routine.

6.4 Contemporary/Lyrical Championship 12U, 14U & 15O

- To qualify, competitors must have performed in two previous Open sections in the categories of Contemporary and Lyrical.
- To qualify, competitors must have performed in a lyrical & Contemporary improvisation section.

On Championship Day:

- Competitors will be required to perform two solos, Dance A will be a Contemporary and dance B the Lyrical.
- One item may be repeated. A change of costume and/or music does not constitute a change of routine.

6.5 Entertainment Championship - 12/under, 14/under and 15/over (no repeat dance)

To qualify, competitors must perform in:

i. **Open Broadway or Open Musical Theatre, and**

ii. **Any One (1) of the following sections:**

- a. Open Jazz,
- b. Open Tap,
- c. Open Hip-Hop,
- d. Acro
- e. Open Song and Dance
- f. Open Song and Tap; and

iii. **Any Two (2) of the following Improv sections:**

- a. Jazz
- b. Tap
- c. Hip-Hop

- **Entertainment Championship – 10/under (repeat dance permitted)**

- To qualify, competitors must have competed in two previous Open sections in the categories of Jazz, Broadway Jazz/Musical Theatre and Fast Tap (2 qualifying routines) and performed in one of the following improvisation sections: Jazz, Tap or Hip Hop.



Entertainment Championship – 8/under (repeat dance permitted)

- To qualify, competitors must have competed in one previous Open section in the categories of Jazz, Broadway Jazz and Tap (1 qualifying routine) and performed in the any style improvisation section.

On Championship Day:

- Competitors will be required to perform one solo **of high entertainment value**, not previously performed (with exception of 10/u and 8/u performers). Dance styles can be Broadway Jazz, Musical Theatre, Fast Tap, Acrobatics, Hip Hop, Contemporary, Student Choreography, Demi-Character or Song and Dance (any style). **Straight Jazz, Classical, Lyrical and National Character routines cannot be performed in this section.**
- The entertainment championship section will be adjudicated on entertainment value and originality.
- There must be a minimum of **two** competitors in this section for it to proceed. In the event that only one competitor is entered the Committee reserves the right to cancel the section or move the competitor up an age grouping, if available.

6.6 Technical Championship - 18 years and over.

- To qualify, competitors must have performed in two previous Open sections in the categories of Contemporary, Lyrical, Classical
- To qualify, competitors must have performed in the 18yrs + lyrical improvisation section.

On Championship Day:

- Competitors will be required to perform two solos of their choice from lyrical, contemporary or classical. Dance A and dance B must not be the same genre.
- One item may be repeated. A change of costume and/or music does not constitute a change of routine.

- 18+ contemporary
- 18+ Classical Ballet
- 18+ Lyrical Improvisation
- **CHAMPIONSHIP DANCES**
- Dance A – Contemporary (Repeat Dance)
- Dance B – Lyrical (Unseen)



6.7 Theatrical Championship - 18 years and over.

- To qualify, competitors must have performed in two previous Open sections in the categories of Jazz, Broadway/Musical Theatre, Tap, Hip Hop.
- To qualify, competitors must have performed in the 18yrs + Jazz improvisation section.

On Championship Day:

- Competitors will be required to perform two solos of their choice from any theatrical style, Jazz, Broadway, Musical Theatre, Tap, or Hip Hop. Dance A and dance B must not be the same genre.
- One item may be repeated. A change of costume and/or music does not constitute a change of routine.
