Rules

- Age as at the first day of Eisteddfod, all dancers must dance in the correct age sections.
- NO REFUNDS, transfers may be offered.
- All dancers / competitors compete at their own risk. Tutus and tapshoes eisteddfod takes NO responsibility for any accidents, injury or death to any persons associated with this Eisteddfod, either as a competitor, volunteer, or a member of the public at any time.
- The adjudicators decision is FINAL, any parents, competitors or teachers approaching the adjudicator will be disqualified and asked to leave the venue.
- All competitors give their permission for photos to be used by Tutus and tap shoes eisteddfod for promotional material, this includes results on social media.

- Due to child protection laws please use change rooms provided
- NO practising in the hall.
- Tap shoes to be covered.
- This event is an alcohol free zone.
- All Programs will be uploaded to social media or emailed.
- No resin is to be used.
- Music to be uploaded to Music uploads
- Sections may be combined if needed due to lack of entries, but adjudicated according to level.
- Copy of child's birth certificate required on first entry.

- Entry not confirmed until payment has been made.
- Prompting will not be permitted except for babies sections.
- There is to be quiet in the hall at all times.
- No dancer is to perform out of section
- Unfinished dances may be repeated at the discretion of the adjudicator except 12yrs and over.
- Tutus and tapshoes reserves the right to change competition days or move location due to unforeseen circumstances.
- Time limits: Babies 2.5 mins, Solos 3 mins
- Music uploads and voice critiques.
- Sections capped at 8 competitors.

Solo section definitions

- First year learning-The competitor must have only recently begun the genre within the 12 month period preceding the commencement of the competition year for that discipline.
 - Specially Restricted- For competitors who have never won that style of dance in any competitions.
 - Restricted- For competitors who have not won restricted in that style, but have won in thespecially restricted for that style (Babies sections are not included)
 - Open- For competitors who have won specially restricted and restricted in that style.
