Dates

Solos and Duos/Trios 18-20 July 2025Solo Championships 20 July 2025

Venue

- Solos and Duos/Trios and championships will be held at Illawarra Sports High School, Guru Street, Berkeley, NSW.
- Free onsite parking is available at the school.
- Stage dimensions are 7M X 7.5M.

Committee

- The Eclipse Dance Challenge (EDC) is an independent competition, and not affiliated with any dance studio.
- The EDC Committee's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Please do not ask us to allocate certain age groups on particular days as we cannot always grant everyone's preferences.
- The EDC Committee reserves the right to:
 - o cancel, amend, and/or combine sections where there are insufficient entries;
 - split sections where there are a large number of competitors. Allocation of dancers in split sections will be by random selection. Competitors must perform in the division allocated;
 - refuse an entry;
 - demand proof of age of an entrant in an age section;
 - o demand proof of amateur or professional status;
 - vary the prizes where needed.

Adjudicators

- The adjudicator's decision is final.
- This is a no protest dance competition. At no time can anyone speak to or approach any adjudicator or the adjudicator's table before, during or after the dance competition to discuss results, except EDC staff.
- The Committee reserves the right to disqualify any Competitor who, or whose parent, guardian or teacher, in its opinion, infringes this rule.
- The Committee reserves the right to appoint substitute adjudicator/s if circumstances require.
- Adjudicator's voice critiques will be uploaded directly into your Music Uploads account at the end of the day. No paper copies will be available.

Age

- Soloists and Duos/Trios age at 1st day of dance competition, Friday 18 July 2025.
- Proof of age may be asked for at the event if deemed necessary by the Committee.

Competitors

- Competition is open to amateurs only. An amateur refers to a person whose principal source of income is not, and has not been derived from the exercise or teaching of a talent related to the competitions in question.
- Competitors must enter and compete in their own age group. No dancing below age is permitted. Dancers may dance above age if the genre they wish to compete in is not available in their own age group.
- No person may enter under a name other than his or her own. Entries are not transferable from one person to another.
- Competitors compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be taken for any accident, injury or loss of property incurred by competitors or any other persons in attendance.
- Competitors must be ready to dance in the order in which their name appears in the program, and will not be allowed to dance out of section.
- No solo competitor will be allowed to dance more than once in any solo section unless sections are combined
- Duos and Trios competitors may enter and perform up to 3 routines in the one section; no repeating routines.
- Solo competitors can repeat their dance after forgetting at the discretion of the adjudicator.
 - o 5U and 7U solo competitors may re-dance their routine without penalty.
 - o 9U solo competitors may re-dance, but will not be eligible for "1st placing".
 - All other ages may re-dance for a voice critique only.
- No repeats of routines are permitted during sections (excluding Championships). A change of costume and/or music does not constitute a change of routine.
- A competitor, who during the three months preceding the opening date of the competition in which he or she has entered, has been taught, coached, managed or advised by the appointed adjudicator of the competition, shall not be eligible to compete in that competition of the dance competition.
- In the event of the change of adjudicator affecting eligibility to enter, you will receive a refund.

Entries

ENTRIES OPEN Monday, 10 February 2025
 ENTRIES CLOSE Sunday, 8 June 2025

- LATE ENTRIES Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Committee, and will incur a late fee of \$5.00 per dance.
- Entries may close early if full capacity is reached prior to closing date.
- Please ensure all entries are correct. In the event of errors, please contact the Committee asap by email and we will endeavour to make any corrections required.
- Entries must be submitted via Comps Online
- Only entries with full payments will be accepted.

Entry fees

Solo sections \$30.00 per routine

• Duo/Trio \$35.00 per duo/trio per routine (all names must be shown)

• Admin fee \$15.00 per family (includes emailed program)

Late fee \$5.00 per routine in addition to solo section entry fee

Solo Championships Free; entry by qualification only

Refunds

 Refunds of entry fees will only be made to an entrant if a section has been cancelled by the Committee.

- Refunds will not be made in case of competitor illness, unavailability or change of mind.
- In the event the EDC is required to be postponed due to NSW health orders, all entries will transfer to the postponed date. Refunds will not be given.

Entry payment details

- Payment must be made electronically at the time of entry via Comps Online.
- No cash or cheques will be accepted for entries.

Time Limits

Solos 3 minutesDuos/Trios 3 minutes

• Time limits will be strictly enforced in all sections. Please ensure the performance is within the allocated time limit. Your co-operation is expected by the Committee.



Music

- It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure the correct music files are uploaded for each routine. You may change your music files at any time within your Music Uploads account before the cutoff dates.
- Competitors are encouraged to bring back up music on USB.
- NO VOCALS are permitted in music tracks for Classical Ballet or Demi-Character sections.
- No background tapping sounds in music tracks allowed for any tap sections.

Prompting

 Prompting is not permitted in any solo, duo/trio, troupe or championship section, except for competitor's aged 6 and under.

Choreography ownership

- Parents, dancers and teachers/choreographers must all be aware of what routines are being performed at EDC.
- If a dancer has left a dance studio, please ensure you have permission from their past choreographers/teachers to be able to continue to perform routines whose ownership may be in question at EDC.
- Disputes in regards to this must be mediated and handled with class (outside of social media or the event itself) by the parties involved, but not involving any EDC Committee members or staff.
- EDC will not get involved in this, and we ask that you do the right thing.

Solo categories

- Restricted sections are for competitors who have never won a first prize in that particular genre, at any age (except 5U and 16+), at any competition, festival or eisteddfod up to the closing date of EDC entries. The restriction applies to the title of the genre, and not to the competitor's routine.
- Open sections are for competitors who have won a first prize in that particular genre in any age group (except 5U and 16+), at any competition, festival or eisteddfod up to the closing day of EDC entries.

Props

- Please ensure props are safe.
- No glass, flammable material, or material that will leave a residue on the stage is permitted.
- Competitors are responsible for clearing the stage after their act of all props. This includes confetti etc. Side stage staff will assist where possible.
- Only props for use-on-the-day may be stored backstage, and must be removed from the venue at the end of session or that night.
- All due care, but no responsibility, will be taken by EDC for props on or off the stage.

Backstage

- Noise in the backstage area and wings must be kept to a minimum at all times.
- No rehearsal will be permitted in backstage corridors.
- No changing will be permitted in backstage corridors or bathrooms.
- A quick-change area will be allocated backstage.
- Only two teachers or representatives (one on each side of the stage) will be allowed backstage with groups in a supervisory capacity.

Dressing Rooms

- Dressing rooms will be provided. No costume changing, makeup or hair to be done in the hall or bathrooms.
- A separate change area will be provided for male competitors.

• Solo tickets can be purchased at the door on the day. EFTPOS facilities will be available.

Video and Photography

- A professional photography and videography service will be available for both solos and troupe events.
- No other private photography or videoing is permitted of performers on stage. This includes the use of video recorders, cameras, mobile phones or any other recording device, either in the auditorium or side stage (official photographers/videographers excepted)
- EDC reserves the right to record, film, broadcast, telecast, videotape or photograph any
 entrant, item or event in the dance competition without notification. Any such photograph,
 recording or broadcast may be used at the Committee's discretion for publicity or
 promotional purposes, but shall not necessarily constitute an endorsement of any entrants.
 No remuneration or compensation whatsoever shall be attributable to any entrants so
 featured.
- Teachers please make sure your troupe parents are aware of this rule. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in immediate disqualification.

Canteen

- Light refreshments will be available for purchase throughout the event.
- EFTPOS and cash payments will be accepted.

Prizes

- Solos, Duos/Trios sections will be awarded medals and/or cash prizes.
- Championship winners will receive a crown and gift bag. Championship special award winners will receive a trophy.

Sportsmanship

- The Eclipse Dance Challenge is a family friendly event.
- Please show respect and silence during a performance, and applaud at the end for everyone. We all share a special journey in the world of performing arts.
- Discourtesy to other competitors will not be tolerated.
- Discourtesy to any Committee members or Volunteers by competitors, parents, friends or dance studio representatives will not be tolerated, and may lead to that person being asked to leave the auditorium and possible disqualification of the competitor/s or dance studio.
- The Committee reserves the right to ask someone to leave who is causing disruption, or refusing to follow the direction of the Committee in the auditorium.

Solo sections

- Restricted sections are available for 7U, 9U, 11U, 13U and 15U competitors only. Restricted
 sections are for competitors who have never won a first prize in that particular genre, at any
 age (except 5U and 16+), at any competition, festival or eisteddfod up to the closing date of
 EDC entries. The restriction applies to the genre, and not to the competitor's routine.
- Open sections are for all 5U and 16+ competitors, and for 7U, 9U, 11U, 13U and 15U competitors who have won a first prize in that particular genre in any age group, at any competition, festival or eisteddfod up to the closing day of EDC entries.

Own choice sections

- Own choice is available as an open section only.
- Any dance genre may be performed in an own choice section; no repeats.
- Available for dancers who may have additional routines they wish to perform, eg.
 One lyrical routine in the Lyrical section, and second lyrical routine in the "own choice" section.
- o Competitors may enter up to two routines in an open own choice section.

Duo/Trio sections

- Time limit 3 minutes
- "Duo/Trio Own choice". Available for duos/trios who may have additional routines they wish to perform, eg. One lyrical routine in the lyrical section, and second lyrical routine in the "own choice" section. Own choice genre not limited to genres listed below, eg. duo/trio may wish to perform a Broadway Jazz or Musical Theatre routine.
- Competitors may enter up to two routines in an open own choice section. This is a great opportunity for dancers to get their additional routines on stage.

Championships

- Championships will be held on Sunday, 20 July 2025
- Venue: Illawarra Sports High, Guru Street, Berkeley, NSW
- Entry into Eclipse Dance Challenge Championships is by qualification only.
- To qualify, the top 8 highest point scorers from the solo sections (unless otherwise specified) will automatically qualify to compete in the championships.
- Highest point scoring routines may be repeated in the championships, or substituted for an alternative routine.
- Dancers qualifying for a Rising Star Championship must perform a restricted dance routine.
- Dancers may qualify for both Rising Star and Superstar Championships if they have competed in both restricted and open EDC's solo sections.

The following Championship special achievement awards will be presented during the Eclipse Dance Challenge championships:

- Outstanding costume design* Awarded to the dancer whose costume displays outstanding creative concept, originality, suitability, age appropriateness, and enhances the overall routine.
- Eclipse Dancer Award* Awarded to the most entertaining solo performer during championships that epitomises that WOW factor; a winning combination of choreography, performance and personality.
- Impact Dancer Award* Awarded to the most memorable solo performance during championships, with consideration given to a variety of achievements such as choreography, emotional execution, precision, technique, etc
- Shooting Star Award* Awarded to the most promising solo dancer during championships
- **Ultimate Champion** Awarded to the highest point scoring solo performer across all age groups and genres during championships

Please note: Special Awards* are not based on marks, and are awarded at the adjudicator and Committee's discretion.
