Please note Entries will not be processed until payment has been received by Lakeside Dance Challenge. Refunds will not be given unless the circumstances allow for this.

Competition Rules

- The adjudicator's decision is final.
- Teachers, parents and competitors approaching the adjudicator will result in disqualification from the competition.
- Solo music must be emailed according to the given instructions by the due date. Music and Lyrics must be relevant to the age of the performers. No offensive or inappropriate lyrics are to be used in any number. This will result in disqualification.
- Voice Critiques will be sent to you via a dropbox link in the few days following the competition.
- A copy of the competitor's birth certificate must accompany the entry form for proof of age. Photo id with a date of birth will also be accepted. If we already have your child's proof of age on file you do not need to supply this again.
- Please make sure you enter your child in the correct section. Please check with your child's teacher the correct style of dance.
- Changes will not be made to the program on the day of the competition.
- Age refers to the age as of 1st January 2023.
- There is a trick limit of 10% to all routines, otherwise the dancers routine becomes an acro routine. If dancers exceed the trick limit there will be a deduction of 10 points to the routine. Any acro routines are to be entered into a variety section.
- There are no repeats allowed except for scholarship sections and Mini Championships.
- Lakeside Dance Challenge reserves the right to merge sections if it is deemed necessary.
- No changes to sections will be made on the day of the competition.
- Lakeside Dance Challenge reserves the right to make changes to venue and dates if deemed necessary. All changes will be announced on our Facebook page and Instagram account.
- Lakeside Dance Challenge reserves the right to make a change in adjudicators at any time.
- Pointe shoes must not be worn by any competitor 12 years and under.
- Any bullying towards competitors, parents, spectators, staff, etc. will result in immediate disqualification.
- Lakeside Dance Challenge will be using photos taken at their events and from social media in their own promotion and social statuses. Please advise us if you wish for this not to occur.
- No refunds will be given except for circumstances that allow for this
- If you are awarded credit (lakeside dollars) you may only use these at regional events. Lakeside dollars cannot be used for National Finals unless that is what they are awarded specifically for. Your Lakeside Dollars will expire after 12months.

Section Levels:

Shining Star: Specially restricted, restricted or novice dancers who have never competed in an open section before.

Superstar: Dancers who compete in open sections and have won in restricted sections.

Age is as of Jan 1 2023 - to coincide with our Finals Rules

Time limit for solos/duos/trios is 3mins max

Championships

To qualify for a championship section you must compete in the regular section for that style first (e.g. you must dance in a Pre-junior jazz to qualify for the Pre-junior jazz championship section.

Mini Any Style - can repeat

Pre-Junior - no repeats Jazz Contemporary Lyrical Classical - one routine only Tap - one routine only

Junior - no repeats Jazz Contemporary Lyrical Classical - one routine only Tap - one routine only

Scholarships

Junior (11/u) Teen (12-14) Senior (15/o) **Pre-Teen** - no repeats Jazz Contemporary Lyrical Classical - one routine only Tap - one routine only

TEEN - no repeats Jazz Contemporary Lyrical Classical - one routine only Tap - one routine only

Senior - no repeats Jazz Contemporary Lyrical Classical - one routine only Tap - one routine only

Please note these age groups are different to normal sections as they are grouped together. *This section requires a dancer to perform two contrasting routines in the same section*. A monetary prize is awarded to the winner only and this amount will vary depending on how many people enter this section.
