AGE RULES

- * Age is determined as of January 1st of the competition year.
- * For example, in the 8 years & under category, all dancers must be either 7 or 8 years of age as of January 1st – obviously a 6 year old can be part of the 8 years and under team but a 9 year old cannot.
- * Age categories are as follows:
 - * 6/u
 - * 8/u
 - * 10/u
 - * 12/u
 - * 14/u
 - * OPEN

ENTRIES

- * Entries must be submitted via Comps Online.
- * Entries will close once maximum capacity is reached or one month prior to the eisteddfod date, whichever occurs first.
- * There are no separate divisions for small or large groups; however, if sufficient entries are received to warrant a small group section, it may be offered.
- * A minimum of five (5) entrants is required for a section to run.

TROUPES & MUSIC

- * Troupes are available in all age groups for the following styles:
 - * Contemporary
 - * Lyrical
 - * Jazz
 - * Hip Hop
 - * Musical Theatre
 - * Ballet
 - * Tap
- * Music duration for all troupes must be no longer than 5 minutes maximum.
- * Once all entries are received, a Dropbox link will be sent to all studios for digital music upload.
- * No music will be accepted on the day.
- * Studios are strongly encouraged to bring a backup copy.

* If music is not received by the required deadline, we will assume the school is not attending.

GENERAL INFORMATION

* An entry fee will be charged at the door for all spectators.

Dancers do not pay to enter the venue.

Two teachers per school also do not pay to enter the venue and will be issued teachers passes.

* Dressing rooms are allocated by management based on school numbers.

Please do not change allocated rooms and ensure spaces are left as found.

* No refunds will be issued, except in the event of a section or event cancellation.

* All competitors and spectators enter at their own risk.

LEVEL UP accepts no responsibility for accident, injury, or loss of property, including motor vehicles.

* Each entry will be adjudicated by a highly qualified judge, and all decisions are final.

Contacting or speaking to judges is strictly prohibited at all times. Please respect their decisions as final.

* Props and/or sets must be set up and removed as quickly as possible.

* All competitors must confirm attendance with the backstage manager. prior to their section commencing.

* Any section with more than 15 competitors may be divided into Parts A and B.

If insufficient numbers are received, the organiser reserves the right to amend or combine sections.

* Tap shoes are not permitted to be worn inside the venue. This rule will be strictly enforced.

* The use of videos, cameras, or mobile phone photography is strictly prohibited and may result in disqualification.

* No smoking or vaping is permitted anywhere on school grounds.

* Entrants must arrive at least one (1) hour prior to their scheduled time.

LEVEL UP reserves the right to run up to one hour early, and holds no responsibility if a competitor misses their event due to the schedule running ahead.

* Once the schedule is released, no studio, teacher, or parent may request a reschedule.

Studios must be prepared to perform at any point during the competition weekend.

* By entering the LEVEL UP Troupe Challenge, all participants agree not to hold LEVEL UP, its staff, directors, or host venue responsible for injury or loss of property.

* All participants grant permission for photographs or video taken by LEVEL UP Troupe Challenge to be used for promotional purposes, including print and digital media.

* LEVEL UP promotes a family-friendly environment.

Routines containing explicit lyrics, suggestive themes, or inappropriate content may incur point deductions.

Good sportsmanship and respectful conduct are expected at all times.

* Trophies are awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.

Please note that ribbons are no longer awarded to all competitors.
