SFD International Syllabus & Freestyle Dance Competition Rules

SFD Syllabus Competition:

1. Students must have completed an SFD Exam (normal or progress) in the 2025 or 2026 exam seasons in order to compete.
2. Students attending a full-time dance course (more than 15 hours per week) or teaching unsupervised for more than 6 hours per week will not be eligible to enter the Syllabus competition.

Entry includes: Either a Trophy or Medal depending on performance score
(1st, 2nd or 3rd place prize winners will receive a trophy)
(Honourable Mentions or Special Mentions will receive a Medal)
Participation Certificates
Photography

SFD Freestyle Competition:

1. Students from any registered Dance School/Studio may enter the Freestyle competition. SFD Members get a special discount if application is received before the Official Closing date. Any late entries must be paid at the full Non Member rate.
2. Competitors in any sections from 19 yrs and below, must not be teaching more than 6 hours per week or studying dance fulltime.
3. 20 yrs & over sections are open to students/performers earning income from full or part time dance teaching.

Registrations:

1. Only SFD Premium Members can receive the special member discount. If you are a Premium Member, please choose the discounted price from the dropdown menu on Comps-Online when you enter.
2. Entries must be lodged via Comps-Online by 6th February 2026 : **SFD International Dance Competition 2026** (payments will be accepted by a PayPal account or credit card).

3. Registrations may close early, if sold out before the closing date.
4. Registration includes a complimentary digital Competition program.
5. The SFD Committee may change or combine sections if insufficient entry numbers are received.
6. Registrations will only be accepted once the full entry fee has been received.
7. Refunds will not be given for non-attendance or change of mind. In the event that SFD is forced to cancel the event due to Government restrictions or other unforeseen circumstances, refunds will be provided less booking fees & credit card fees.
8. For Duos, Trios & Quads, the names and birth dates of each competitor must be given at the time of entry.
9. Performers must compete under the name that they have registered with and cannot be swapped.
10. Competitors can only enter within their own age group.
11. Late entries may be accepted on request, at the Non-Member price only.

Age:

1. The competitor's age will be taken from **1st January 2026**.
2. The correct date of birth of each entrant must be supplied at the time of registration.
3. For Duos, Trios, Quads and Troupes, the section entered will be determined by the age of the oldest entrant.
4. Proof of Age must be presented upon request. Prizes may be withheld until ID has been sighted.

Freestyle Time Limits:

1. Solos, Duos Trios & Quads 3 mins
2. Troupes 5 mins

Music:

1. Teachers must ensure that music choices are suitable for family audiences.
2. SFD will provide music for all exercises in the Syllabus Competition and for students who are using the Set Exam Dance music. Teachers choosing to use different exam dance music must refer to Point 3 below.
3. Once the SFD International Competition digital program has been sent, Teachers will be asked to submit their students' music to sfdcompmusic@gmail.com.
 - **For Teacher's Own Choice Exam Dance Music** - the **Style & Level** must be listed in the **Music file name** and your email should clearly list each performer who will be dancing to that specific track title.
 - **For the Freestyle Competition** - the **section number, performer number** and **performer name** must be listed in each music file name.
4. Teachers must bring a back-up copy of their music on USB and on a device, in case of faults.
5. If there is a music issue, the following procedures will occur:
 - a) **If music is skipping or playing up during a competitor's dance**, the adjudicator will turn off the music allowing students to continue without music.
 - b) **If a competitor stops dancing and leaves the stage due to faulty music/jumping/stretched/skipping** they will be given the option of repeating their dance, without disqualification.
 - c) **If a competitor continues dancing without music, they will not be disqualified.** They will be given the option of repeating their dance at the end of the section with music.
 - d) **If music is faulty on a repeat performance**, the competitor can decide whether to leave the stage or continue without music. The competitor will not be disqualified for music issues beyond their control.

Adjudication:

1. International Adjudicators will be appointed by the SFD Committee.
2. The Committee reserves the right to substitute an Adjudicator in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
3. **The competitor and teacher must accept as final any decision made by the Adjudicator(s) and no correspondence will be entered into.**

General Rules

1. The Committee reserves the right to amend the program, to divide or combine any section, and to cancel any section if insufficient entries are received. Entry fees will be refunded if a section is cancelled.
2. a) Competitors must arrive and be ready backstage, at least **30 minutes** prior to the publicised start of their section.
b) Competitors must remain in their designated dressing room area until summoned by an SFD representative.
c) Competitors must be ready to take their places on stage at the given time and must compete in the order in which their names appear on the running sheet.
d) If not present when called upon, competitors are liable for disqualification.
3. All Choreography, Music and Costuming must be suitable for a family audience.
4. Teachers will be permitted to remain side stage for the duration of their student's dance items only.
5. The Committee reserves the right to disqualify any competitor for any action not in accordance with any of the rules of the Southern Federation Dance Competitions.
6. It is agreed upon entering this competition that participants, including students, parents, teachers and other spectators, will not hold Southern Federation of Dance or its committee or volunteers, or host facilities liable for injuries sustained, illnesses contracted by them or loss of property while in attendance and/or participating in any activity related to this event.
7. No alcohol is permitted to be consumed by competitors at any time while the competition is in progress. Drinking of alcohol in any part of the theatre will result in disqualification and the offender will be asked to leave the theatre immediately.
8. No lighted candles, naked flames, fresh fruit, flowers, vegetables or glass may be used on stage.
9. All props must be able to be set up or removed within 30 seconds. A responsible adult must accompany a competitor with props, to help position them on stage. No curtains will be provided to place props on stage.
10. SFD will not post or arrange collection of any prizes once the event has closed.
11. No personal filming or photography is allowed in dressing rooms.
12. No cell phones, iPads, video cameras, cameras or any recording devices may be used by the audience during any performance. **Please do NOT take videos or photos while competitors are dancing. Anyone caught recording or photographing will have all professionally filmed videos and photos withheld, until the personal footage has been deleted and removed from any social media sites.**

Syllabus Competition Rules:

1. If a competitor leaves the stage before completing all of their exercises and exam dance, they will not be eligible for a 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize but may receive an Honourable Mention or Special Mention at the adjudicator's discretion.
2. Late competitors who miss their allotted competition time, will not be able to perform.
3. Exam style uniform or dancewear should be worn that clearly shows all body lines. Participants will not be assessed on what they wear. (Make-up is optional).
4. Students will be assigned a number to be worn whilst on stage.

Freestyle Competition Rules:

1. If a competitor leaves the stage before completing their dance (for reasons other than music issues) and requests a second attempt, they will be placed at the end of the section and will still be eligible for a trophy prize, with a deduction of points.
2. Late competitors who miss their section, will not be able to perform.
3. If a performer is scheduled to perform again within 8 dances of a previous section, their order may be changed if approved by the Competition organiser and once adjudicators have been advised.
4. Freestyle Competitors must comply strictly with the time limits stated. They will not be adjudicated after the specific time has elapsed and are liable for disqualification for any breach of this rule.
5. No lighted candles, naked flames, fresh fruit, flowers, vegetables or glass may be used on stage.
6. All props must be able to be set up or removed within 30 seconds. A responsible adult must accompany a competitor with props, to help position them on stage. No curtains will be provided to place props on stage.
7. **Competitors in Under 13 sections MUST NOT wear pointe shoes.**
8. If registering performers in "Other styles", the teacher must list the name of the performer and the style of dance they are presenting, in the questionnaire at the end of the registration process.
9. Highest Scoring Trophies will only be provided if there are enough entries and/or sponsors.

Media and Publicity Consent:

SFD may use brief excerpts of videos or photographs of dancers for promotional purposes. By participating in this competition, you consent to having photos or videos taken by SFD. If any performer does not give consent for their image/s to be shared, it is the responsibility of the parent/performer/teacher to notify SFD in advance. Please ensure that the performer knows to step out of any publicity photos or videos.

SFD International Dance Competition

Style Descriptions

Classical: is a routine that consists of classical steps & ballet technique that highlights graceful style, posture, turnout and controlled footwork. Ballet Shoes must be worn or pointe shoes are acceptable for students 13 yrs and over, if strong enough. Music can be orchestral or piano/instrumental. Can include repertoire and story ballets (demi-character).

Jazz: is a routine that utilises jazz technique that incorporates dynamics and high energy movement qualities. Teachers can choose to use Modern or Broadway style music.

Lyrical: is a style of routine that combines ballet and jazz techniques. It is performed to music with lyrics that inspire the movements and emotions and may be linked to a storyline.

Contemporary: is a style of dance movement, which may be abstract or fluid, that joins elements of ballet, jazz, and modern dance. Non-traditional lines and shapes can be used and choreography may incorporate a storyline, theme or mood.

Hip Hop: consists of street styles of dance that may include popping, locking, breaking, and other urban dance techniques. K-pop and J-pop can also be entered in this category.

Other Styles: Can include Tap, Pom, Cheerleading, Acrobatics, National Dances from different countries. For more style options, please contact us on info@dancesfd.asn.au for approval.

Choreography for the Freestyle competition must be original and not replicated from popular dance videos. No more than 8 counts of SFD Syllabus exercises or SFD set dance choreography may be used in any freestyle dance routines.

Eligible recipients may also choose to enter the SFD Junior or Major Scholarship (if they have completed an SFD exam within the last 2 years) which includes a Technical Workshop Class and an onstage performance of either a Classical, Jazz or Tap Solo, plus up to 3 other solo items, at our prestigious, sell-out Melbourne competition. A full schedule of Scholarship Rules for the Melbourne competition will be distributed to qualifying winners of these awards.

This initiative is designed to recognise excellence, encourage cultural exchange, and provide talented dancers with a pathway to perform internationally within a supportive and professional competition environment.
